#### MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held in the Municipal Office on Saturday, November 14, 1914.

THE Council met this day at 2 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 9, 1914.

Present :-- The Hon. Mr. R. B. Hellings, Chairman ; Mr. D. G. Goonewardena ; Mr. H. M. Makan Markar ; Mr. D. W. Subesingha; Dr. C. B. Lourensz; Mr. C. E. de Vos; Mr. G. E. Abeywardena; Mr. A. C. Hayley; Mr. J. E. Perera; and Mr. W. R. W. Morgan.

1. The Minutes of the General Meeting of Council held on October 10, 1914, a copy of which was sent to each Councillor, were taken as read.

Resolved-That the Minutes of the General Meeting of Council held on October 10, 1914, be confirmed.

2. Letter No. 551 dated October 15, 1914, from Mr. P. M. Bingham, Provincial Engineer, resigning his appointment as a Councillor owing to his transfer from the Province.

The Chairman moved that this Council do place on record its sense of appreciation of Mr. P. M. Bingham's services to the Council, and its regret at his departure from Galle. Mr. D. G. Goonewardena seconded.-Carried unanimously.

3. The ballot taken for a Member on the Standing Committee on Municipal Works in the room of Mr. P. M. Bingham resulted in Mr. W. R. W. Morgan being elected to fill the vacancy.

The Chairman moved that Mr. W. R. W. Morgan be appointed to serve on the following Special Committees in the room of Mr. P. M. Bingham :--(1) Special Committee on Lighting; (2) Special Committee on Drainage; (3) Special Committee on Hiyare Reservoir. Mr. H. M. Makan Markar seconded.--Carried unanimously.

5. Report of the Superintendent of the Colombo Fire Brigade on fire protection of Galle. The Chairman moved that a Special Committee consisting of Messrs. D. W. Subesingha, A. C. Hayley, W. R. W. Morgan, and himself, two to form a quorum, be appointed to report on the fire protection of Galle. Mr. D. G. Goonewardena seconded.-Carried unanimously.

Papers re address and casket presented by the Council to His Excellency the Governor.

The Chairman read the following extract from a letter received by him from His Excellency the Governor's Private Secretary :--- "His Excellency directed me ..... to thank you and, through you, the Municipal Council of Galle for the handsome casket, which will always be to him a permanent memento of an enjoyable visit."
