VITAL STATISTICS OF CEYLON.

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL OF MARRIAGES, BIRTHS, AND DEATHS FOR
THE SECOND QUARTER OF 1914.

I.—Population.

The estimated population on the last day of the quarter was 4,251,088, showing an increase of 6,740 on the previous quarter, due to an excess of 8,707 births over deaths and a deficit of 1,967 arrivals over departures of Indian coolies.

2. *Indian Coolies.*—During the quarter 30,471 Indian coolies arrived in the Island and 32,438* left, as against averages of 36,188 and 20,201 respectively.

II.—Marriages.

3. 5,235 marriages (other than Muhammadan marriages) were registered during the quarter, as against 5,682 during the preceding quarter, 5,493 during the second quarter of 1913, and 4,560 the mean of the ten preceding second quarters. Of these, 4,157 were under the "General Marriages" Ordinance and 1,078 under the Kandyan. Their distribution by provinces and districts is given in Table I. in the Appendix.

III.—Births.

4. The births registered in the Island during the quarter totalled 42,179, corresponding to an annual rate of 39·9 per 1,000 of the population. This rate is 3·8 below that of the previous quarter, and 1·2 below that of the corresponding quarter of 1913, but is 2·9 higher than the mean birth-rate of the ten preceding second quarters. The births in estates correspond to an annual rate of 41·7 per 1,000, and the urban births, including those of Colombo, to 27·14. The Colombo rate was 20·89. For detailed statistics see Tables I. to V., VII., and VIII.

There were 264 stillbirths registered in the thirty-two towns, as against 300 in the previous quarter and 237 in the corresponding quarter of last year. (See Table VIII.) Stillbirths are not registered in the rural registration divisions.

IV.—Deaths.

5. The deaths from all causes registered in the Island during the quarter numbered 33,472, and corresponded to an annual rate of 31·6 per 1,000 persons living. This rate is 3·2 higher than the mean rate in the ten preceding second quarters, and 4·7 than the rate in the corresponding quarter of last year. The first quarter of a year is usually an unhealthy period, and the quarter under review shows a great improvement (10·4) on that quarter. This improvement is shared by every province, excepting the Eastern, and is specially marked in the Northern, North-Western, and North-Central Provinces. The rate in the quarter ranged from 22·4 in the Western Province—which alone showed a lower rate than the average—to 48·9 in the Eastern; in the districts the death-rate varied between 19·0 both in Negombo and Chilaw and 51·7 in Trincomalee. The mortality on estates during the quarter corresponded to a crude annual death-rate of 46·5 per mille, as against an average of 31·4. The rate was highest in the estates in the Ratnapura District, 94·3 (average 61·8), and was very high in the Matara and Kurunegala estates, 72·9 (average 29·9) and 77·5 (average 26·0) respectively. The urban mortality was 28·7 per mille (average 28·25). Among the towns (excluding Vavuniya and Lunugala, which have a population under 1,000, and Nuwara Eliya, in which the population is largely migratory) the lowest mortality during the quarters was recorded in Panadure, 16·86 per mille, and the highest in Mullaittivu, 86·05, followed by 77·97 in Trincomalee, 69·43 in Anuradhapura, and 68·25 in Ratnapura. In the town of Colombo the death-rate was 24·37 (average 28·72). For detailed statistics see Tables I. to VI., VII., and VIII.

V.—Infantile Mortality.

6. The infantile mortality in the Island measured by the proportion of deaths under one year of age to registered births was 192 per 1,000 for all races. The highest rate among the Sinhalese was 406 in the Batticaloa, among the Tamils 378 in the Trincomalee, and among the Moors 327 in the Puttalam Districts; the lowest was 114 for Sinhalese in the Colombo District. The estate infantile mortality rate was 226; it reached its maximum, 500 per 1,000, in the estates of the Matara District, and the minimum 189 in the estates of the Kalutara District. In the towns the infantile mortality was 251 per 1,000 births registered, as against an average of 260, and ranged from 47 in Badulla and 54 in Panadure to 792 in Anuradhapura. Colombo town recorded 262, against an average of 327.

* The figures are taken from the Monthly Statements of Arrivals and Departures published in the *Government Gazette*, and include (since the opening of the Indo-Ceylon Railway) miscellaneous passengers, which partly accounts for the increase.

VI.—Causes of Death.

7. Of the total deaths, 33,472 registered during the quarter, more than 13 per cent. were reported as due to *Pyrexia*—a vague term descriptive of one of the symptoms of various diseases. In towns and estates the percentage of deaths from this cause was nearly 1 and 2 respectively. Other causes of deaths in the Island during the quarter were *Diarrhea and Enteritis*, 12 per cent. of the total deaths; *Infantile Convulsions*, 10 per cent.; *Diseases of the Skin and of the Cellular Tissue*, 7 per cent.; *Diseases of Early Infancy*, 5 per cent.; *Dysentery*, 4 per cent.; *Tuberculosis, Rickets, Diseases and Accidents of Pregnancy and Childbirth, Pneumonia, Anæmia, Dropsy, and Senility*, 3 per cent. each; *Intestinal Parasites, Anchyllostomiasis, and Malaria or Malarial Cachexia*, 2 per cent. each; *Bronchitis*, 1 per cent. *Vide Table X.* for detailed statistics.

8. Plague which broke out for the first time in Ceylon during the last quarter still continues, but as against 119 deaths registered during that quarter there were only 99 deaths this quarter, of which 95 were within the Municipal limits of Colombo and 4 elsewhere (2 in Colombo District, 1 in Galle, and 1 in Jaffna).

9. There were 3 deaths from Smallpox (2 in Kalutara District and 1 in Matara), and 5 deaths from Cholera (4 in Galle District and 1 in Colombo).

10. Affections caused by external causes—

(a) *Suicide*.—50 deaths were due to suicide, against 58 in the previous quarter and 59 in the corresponding quarter of last year.

(b) *Homicide*.—50 deaths were due to Homicide, against 61 in the previous quarter and 48 in the corresponding quarter of last year. Of these, 4 were caused by firearms and 27 by cutting or piercing instruments.

(c) *Executions*.—8 judicial executions took place during the quarter, against 12 in the previous quarter and 4 in the corresponding quarter of last year.

(d) *Accidents*.—Of the 460 deaths attributed to violence, 95 were due to drowning (29 in wells and 7 in pits), 87 to falls from trees, 58 to snake-bites, and 45 to burns (of which 4 were due to kerosine oil lamps). Vehicles caused 23 deaths, landslides 14, and lightning 12.

11. *Causes of Deaths in the Estates*.—The chief causes of mortality in the estates were *Diarrhoea and Enteritis*, which accounted for 19 per cent. of the total deaths; *Dysentery*, 15 per cent.; *Anchyllostomiasis*, 11 per cent.; *Diseases of Early Infancy*, 11 per cent. (including *Debility*, 9 per cent.); *Pneumonia*, 7 per cent.; *Convulsions of Infants*, 6 per cent.; *Senility*, 4 per cent.; *Malaria or Malarial Cachexia*, 3 per cent.; *Dropsy*, 2 per cent.; *Bronchitis* and *Tuberculosis*, 1 per cent. each. For detailed statistics see Table XI.

12. *Causes of Deaths in the Towns*.—In the 32 towns in the Island (inclusive of Colombo) of the total number of deaths, *Diarrhoea* and *Pneumonia* accounted for 9 per cent. each; *Malaria or Malarial Cachexia*, 8 per cent.; *Phthisis*, 7 per cent.; *Convulsions of Infants*, 6 per cent.; *Dysentery*, 5 per cent.; *Anchyllostomiasis*, 4 per cent.; *Bronchitis*, 3 per cent.; *Enteritis*, 2 per cent.; *Enteric Fever*, 1 per cent. Seven per cent. of the deaths in Colombo were due to Plague. For detailed statistics see Table XII.

13. Comments and Tables usually devoted to the Municipality of Colombo have been excluded as in the previous quarter, as these find a place in the Quarterly Reports of the Medical Officer of Health of that city.
