PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ROBERT CHALMERS, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

KNOW Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in the exercise of the powers vested in Us by section 13 of the Volunteer Ordinance, No. 8 of 1910, do hereby call out for active service the following member of a corps of the Ceylon Volunteer Force:—

Given at Colómbó, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Fifth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fourteen.
