VITAL STATISTICS OF CEYLON.

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL OF MARRIAGES, BIRTHS, AND DEATHS FOR  
THE THIRD QUARTER OF 1914.

I.—Population.

THE estimated population on the last day of the quarter was 4,258,420, showing an increase of 7,332 on the previous quarter, due to an excess of 345 arrivals over departures of Indian coolies and of 6,987 births over deaths.

2. *Indian Coolies*.—During the quarter 27,579 Indian coolies arrived in the Island and 27,234 left, as against averages of 31,970 and 14,935 respectively. The figures are taken from the monthly statements published in the *Government Gazette*, and, since the opening of the Indo-Ceylon Railway, include (in the case of departures) miscellaneous passengers who could not be distinguished from departing coolies, and so swell the number in the statistics.

II.—Marriages.

3. 6,573 marriages (other than Muhammadan marriages) were registered during the quarter, as against 5,235 during the preceding quarter, 7,051 during the third quarter of 1913, and 5,744 the mean of the ten preceding third quarters. Of these, 5,146 were under the "General Marriages" Ordinance and 1,427 under the Kandyan. Their distribution by Provinces and Districts is given in Table I. in the Appendix.

III.—Births.

4. The births registered in the Island during the quarter totalled 36,702, corresponding to an annual rate of 34·2 per 1,000 of the population. This rate is almost the same as the average and the rate in the corresponding quarter of the previous year, but is 5·7 below the rate of the preceding quarter. The births on estates correspond to an annual rate of 37·9 per 1,000, and the urban births, including those of Colombo, to 25·25. The Colombo rate was 21·41. For detailed statistics see Tables I. to V., VII., and VIII.

There were 223 stillbirths registered in the thirty-two towns, as against 264 in the previous quarter and 223 in the corresponding quarter of last year. (See Table VIII.) Stillbirths are not registered in the rural registration divisions.

IV.—Deaths.

5. The deaths from all causes registered in the Island during the quarter numbered 29,715, and corresponded to an annual rate of 27·7 per 1,000 persons living. This rate is below the mean rate in the ten preceding third quarters and the rate in the preceding quarter, but is slightly in excess of the rate in the corresponding quarter of last year. In the Provinces the rate ranged from 21·0 in the Western to 45·1 in the Province of Uva; in the Districts it varied between 16·9 in Negombo and 45·1 in Badulla. The mortality on estates during the quarter corresponded to a crude annual death-rate of 42·4 per mille, as against an average of 36·3. The rate was highest in the estates in the Ratnapura District, 76·3, average 67·1. Among the towns (excluding Vavuniya and Lunugala, which have a population under 1,000, and Nuwara Eliya, in which the population is largely migratory) the lowest mortality during the quarter was recorded in Kegalla, 5·59 per mille, and the highest in Anuradhapura, 65·48. In the town of Colombo the death-rate was 28·19, as against an average of 31·19 for the same quarter of the last 6 years. For detailed statistics see Tables I. to VI., VII., and VIII.

V.—Infantile Mortality.

6. The infantile mortality in the Island measured by the proportion of deaths under one year of age to registered births was 187 per 1,000 for all races. The highest rate for the Sinhalese was 297 in the Puttalam District, for the Tamils 312 in the Mannar District, and for the Moors 234 in the Batticaloa District; the lowest was 126 for the Sinhalese in the Negombo District. The estate infantile mortality was 256 per 1,000, and it reached the maximum 531 per 1,000 in the estates of the Kurunegala District and the minimum 150 in the estates of the Matara District. In the towns the infantile mortality was 248 per 1,000 births registered, as against an average of 277, and ranged from 149 in Weligama to 556 in Anuradhapura. Colombo town recorded 265, against an average of 345.

VI.—Causes of Death.

7. Of the total deaths, 29,715 registered during the quarter, nearly 18 per cent. were reported as due to *Pyrexia*—a vague term descriptive of one of the symptoms of various diseases. In towns and estates the percentage of deaths from this cause was .6 and 1 respectively. Other causes of deaths in the Island during the quarter were *Diarrhœa* and *Enteritis*, 12 per cent. of the total deaths; *Infantile Convulsions*, 11 per cent.; *Diseases of the Skin and Cellular Tissue*, 6 per cent.; *Diseases of Early Infancy*, 5 per cent.; *Pneumonia* and *Tuberculosis*, 4 per cent. each; *Dysentery*, *Rickets*, *Senility*, *Diseases of the Puerperal State*, and *Anæmia*, 3 per cent. each; *Anchylostomiasis* and *Malaria* or *Malarial Cachexia*, 2 per cent. each. Vide Table X. for detailed statistics.

8. Plague which broke out in the first quarter of the year and has continued into the quarter under review accounted for 109 deaths registered, including 101 within the Municipal limits of Colombo and 8 elsewhere (5 in Colombo District, 1 in Kurunegala town, and 2 in Kegalla District).

9. There were 44 deaths from Smallpox (21 in Badulla District, 19 in Colombo, 3 in Kandy, and 1 in Hambantota); and 10 from Cholera (8 in Nuwara Eliya District and 2 in Colombo).

10. Affections caused by external causes—

(a) *Suicide*.—57 deaths were due to suicide, against 50 in the previous quarter and 72 in the corresponding quarter of last year.

(b) *Homicide*.—50 deaths were due to homicide, against 50 in the previous quarter and 45 in the corresponding quarter of last year. Of these, 2 were caused by firearms and 29 by cutting or piercing instruments.

(c) *Executions*.—5 judicial executions took place during the quarter, against 8 in the previous quarter and 2 in the corresponding quarter of last year.

(d) *Accidents*.—Of the 423 deaths attributed to violence, 92 were due to drowning (of these, 30 were drowned in wells and 5 in pits), 92 to falls from trees, and 35 to burns (of which 8 were caused by kerosine oil lamps). Snakebite caused 51 deaths, vehicles 22, and landslips 12. There were 10 deaths due to injuries by animals.

11. *Causes of Deaths in the Estates*.—The chief causes of mortality in the estates were *Diarrhœa* and *Enteritis*, which accounted for 17 per cent. of the total deaths; *Diseases of Early Infancy*, 13 per cent.; *Dysentery* and *Debility of Infants*, 12 per cent. each; *Anchylostomiasis*, 10 per cent.; *Convulsions of Infants* and *Pneumonia*, 8 per cent. each; *Senility*, 4 per cent.; *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, 2 per cent.; *Bronchitis* and *Phthisis*, 1 per cent. each. For detailed statistics see Table XI.

12. *Causes of Deaths in the Towns*.—In the 32 towns in the Island (inclusive of Colombo) of the total number of deaths, *Pneumonia* accounted for 10 per cent.; *Diarrhœa*, *Phthisis*, and *Convulsions of Infants*, 8 per cent. each; *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, 7 per cent.; *Dysentery*, 5 per cent.; *Anchylostomiasis* and *Enteritis*, 4 per cent. each; *Bronchitis*, 3 per cent.; *Enteric Fever*, 1 per cent. Six per cent. of the deaths in Colombo were due to Plague. For detailed statistics see Table XII.
