## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1915.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy—maha: nil, excepting in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division, where the crop has been reaped. Yala: the plants are thriving.

Dry grain: chenas have been sown with kurakkan.

Other products: (a) coconut prospects are satisfactory; (b) fruit, such as oranges, pineapples, and jak, are obtainable; (c) vegetables can be had at moderate prices.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at from Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at from Rs. 35 to Rs. 55 per 1,000.

Rainfall: sufficient rain fell during the month.

Harvest prospects: generally satisfactory.

Health of inhabitants: satisfactory, but there have been a few cases of chickenpox and of enteric fever in Alutkuru Korale South, Siyane Korale West, Hewagam korale, and in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division.

Health of cattle: good, except for a few cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division.

## CENTRAL PROVINCE.

## KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala fields are in plants. Maha cultivation is not commenced yet.

Dry grain : yala chenas are in plants. Cultivation of maha chenas not commenced yet.

Coconut cultivation : flowering has been fair.

Weather : there has been sufficient rain during the month.

Prices of staple articles : rice, Rs. 5.25 to Rs. 6.25 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 4 per 100.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

## NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall : Nuwara Eliya town, 3.53 in.

Paddy : maha cultivation fields in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane are being harvested. Kotmale fields are being ploughed.

Dry grains : no chena work.

Health of population : fever is prevailing in some parts of Uda Hewaheta and Walapane, and dysentery at Theripaha in the latter division.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel ; Indian corn, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; rice (Coast), Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; rice (country), Rs. 4 to Rs. 5.50 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 9 to Rs. 12 per 100 nuts.

## SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

## GALLE DISTRICT.

The prospects of the yala crop are fair, though some damage to the cultivation in the gravets by floods is reported.

Dry grain is cultivated in the district only on a small scale.

Coconuts, tea, cinnamon, and vegetables were the general products. The estimated coconut crop for the month was 12,257,976 nuts. Vegetables produced in some parts of the district were in excess of the local demand.

Coast rice varied from Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; paddy varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 3.25 per bushel ; fine grain varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel ; coconuts varied from Rs. 30 to Rs. 45 per 1,000.

Rainfall was plentiful during the early part of the month, but scanty during the latter part.

The maha crop was fairly good.

The health of the people was on the whole satisfactory, but a few cases of chickenpox and dysentery occurred in some parts of the district.
