

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Bogahahena, &c., Komegahahenawatta, Rupehena, &c., situate in the village of Murungagasyaya, in the East Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."




