Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Public Servants' Liabilities (Continuance) Ordinance, No. 13 of 1915," and shall be read as one with "The Public Servants' (Liabilities) Ordinance, 1899."

Revival of "The Public Servants' (Liabilities) Ordinance, 1899."

2 "The Public Servants' (Liabilities) Ordinance, 1899" (except section 5 thereof), is hereby revived as though the same had never expired, and shall continue in force without any limitation of its duration.

Savings.

3 Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect—

(a) Any action instituted,

(b) Any remedy in respect of any liability contracted, between the 31st day of December, 1914, and the 27th day of May, 1915.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Crown Leases Ordinance No. 15 of 1915."

2 The provisions of the Crown Grants Ordinances, 1884, shall apply and shall be deemed at all times to have applied to Crown leases in all respects as if they were Crown grants.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Medical Wants (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 16 of 1915."

Substitution of new section 13.

2 For section 13 of the principal Ordinance the following new section shall be substituted:

Duties of kanganies.

13 (1) It shall be the duty of every kangani employed upon an estate to give information to the superintendent of every birth, death, and case of sickness or accident in his gang.

(2) Any kangani who shall fail so to do shall be guilty of an offence against this Ordinance.

Addition of new sub-sections to section 27 of the principal Ordinance.

3 The following sub-sections shall be added to section 27 of the principal Ordinance, and shall be numbered (2) and (3), section 27 being re-numbered 27 (1):

(2) In the case of any produce not directly exported by the proprietor of the estate, such rules may provide for the calculation as nearly as may be upon such evidence as the Committee may determine of the amount of export duty paid upon such produce, and any amount so calculated shall for the purpose of the allowance of rebate be deemed to have been paid upon exportation.

(3) Such rules shall be deemed to have effect as from the 1st day of January, 1914.
