2. No such bidding shall be finally accepted unless the person making the same shall, on being declared the highest bidder, immediately pay to the Government Agent of the Northern Province 25 per cent. on the purchase amount; and unless the said person shall, on his being declared the highest bidder as aforesaid, sign these conditions of sale and the description of the system proposed for irrigation of the land attached to the notice of sale.

3. The purchaser shall thereupon be put in possession of the land, and shall clear and prepare for paddy cultivation a quarter of the land annually.

4. No timber shall be allowed to be removed from the land. All the marketable firewood, which should consist of species approved by the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Jaffna, shall be cut and stacked in an accessible portion of the land, and instructions from the Forest Department regarding the dimensions of the firewood and methods of stacking shall be followed. The Assistant Conservator of Forests shall, on receiving information from the purchaser, take over the firewood, paying to the purchaser 25 cents for every cubic yard of firewood stacked in the manner aforesaid. The Assistant Conservator of Forests shall not be held liable to pay for any shrinkage of firewood between the time of stacking and the time of removal. The rest of the timber, except such as is required for fencing the land, shall be burnt on the land.

5. The purchaser shall pay the balance of the purchase money to the said Government Agent in three equal yearly instalments, the first of which shall be considered due at the expiration of one year from the day of sale.

6. In failure of paying any one of the said instalments at the proper time, or in case of non-fulfilment of any of the above conditions as to cultivation or disposal of firewood, the purchase shall be considered void, and the Crown shall have the right to resume the land without repayment of any money paid or compensation for improvements made or any alleged expenses on any account whatever.

7. On payment to the Government Agent of the whole of the purchase money, and on fulfilment of all the conditions aforesaid, the purchaser shall receive, under the Public Seal of the Island, a grant of the said land, to be by him held in free and common socage, yielding every year to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, a quit rent of a peppercorn, and subject also to such regulations as now exist or which may hereafter be enacted relative to landed property in general.

8. The purchaser, his heirs or assigns, shall at all times after the purchase define and keep the boundaries of the said land, according to the limits laid down in the survey, in a state of preservation, either by means of fences, palings, banks, or boundary pillars; and in failure of his defining and preserving the boundaries as aforesaid, the same shall be done by the Government Agent, and the cost and charges thereof shall be recoverable from the said purchaser, his heirs or assigns.

9. Should any error or mistake hereafter appear in the description and admeasurement of the said land, the purchaser shall not be entitled to claim any compensation or abatement of the price in respect thereof.

10. The removal or destruction of any Government trigonometrical station or beacon, or boundary pillar, on the said land will render the purchaser liable to a fine for impeding survey operations, and to all expenses incurred in refixing and restoring such object.

**Description of the System proposed for Irrigation of Land which will be Irrigable by the Karachchi Scheme in the Northern Province.**

The land will be irrigable by the Karachchi Irrigation Scheme when that scheme is completed, but Government does not guarantee to irrigate the land.

2. It is intended to divide up the irrigable area under the scheme into convenient tracts of approximately 200 to 500 acres in extent. The proprietors of land in each of these tracts will be empowered jointly to deal with Government.

3. It is proposed by Government to fix the irrigation rates from time to time, and to offer irrigation at those rates to the proprietors of the land in each tract. It will be left to the proprietors in each tract jointly to decide whether they will or will not take water at the rates proposed.

4. Machinery will be provided by an Ordinance which is shortly to be introduced, which will enable the proprietors jointly to arrive at decisions as to whether they will take irrigation or not, and to give those decisions legal effect.

5. It is proposed, generally, to fix the rates quinquennially and to make the agreements as to the payment of rates and taking of irrigation between Government and the proprietors in a tract binding on each proprietor for a quinquennium.

6. For the first five years from the date on which the irrigation scheme will be able to supply water it is proposed to fix the following rates. For the first year water will be supplied without charge, and for the remaining four years the following charges will be made:—

*North-East Monsoon Crop.*

Rs. 2 per acre if a crop is grown requiring any irrigation between November 1 and March 15.



*South-West Monsoon Crop.*

Rs. 4 per acre if a crop is grown requiring any irrigation between March 15 and November 1.

One watering or part of a watering in the second season will render the land liable for the rate for that season.

The rates will be charged on the whole area of a proprietor's holding, and not on the area cultivated only.

If a separate crop is grown in each season both rates will be charged, that is, Rs. 6 per acre.

7. When the purchase money for land is to be paid in four yearly instalments, the irrigation rates will be recovered as follows:—

For the calendar year in which the sale takes place, water will be supplied free.

For the second calendar year, rate will be recovered on one-half of the area.

For the third calendar year, on three-quarters of the area.

For the fourth calendar year, on the whole area.

The rates for each year, except the first, will be those chargeable at the time as fixed in accordance with paragraph 3.

8. When land is purchased outright, water will be given free of rate during the calendar year in which the sale takes place. Thereafter the rates in force for the time being as fixed in accordance with paragraph 3 will be recovered on the whole area.

9. It is proposed by Government to construct channels which will carry the water to the highest part of each tract. The proprietors will be required to construct their own field channels therefrom. These field channels will be small and inexpensive.

*N.B.*—It should clearly be understood—

(1) That the above description does not bind the Government, but merely indicates the scheme which the Government intends and hopes to carry out; and

(2) That if the scheme is carried out, the minority of the proprietors of any block will on any decision under paragraph 3 be bound by the majority.
