ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1915.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha : fields are being prepared for the maha cultivation. Yala : the plants are thriving well, but in some parts of Alutkuru Korale South and Siyane Korale West they were under water, owing to continual rain.

Dry grain : nil, excepting in Hewagam korale, Siyane Korale West, and Siyane Korale East where the kurakkan plants are thriving well.

Other products : (a) prospects of coconuts are satisfactory ; (b) oranges, pineapples, breadfruits, and jak can be obtained ; and (c) vegetables can be had at moderate prices.

Price of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel ; and (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 28 to Rs. 55 per thousand.

Rainfall : heavy rain prevailed during the month.

Harvest prospects : satisfactory.

Health of inhabitants : good, excepting a few cases of enteric fever, dysentery, and chickenpox in Alutkuru Korale South, and in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division.

Health of cattle : satisfactory, but two cases of cattle murrain occurred in Siyane Korale East.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the plants of the yala cultivation are in ear in some places, and much damage has been done by the recent floods.

Dry grain : nil.

Other products : vegetables and fruit were very scarce in totamunes and Pasdun Korale West, but in Rayigam korale there was a fair supply. There was not much of yam cultivation in the Pasdun Korale West. Flowering of coconuts was fair, and the month's crop was estimated at 2,581,500.

Price of staple products : price of imported rice was from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel, and country rice was Rs. 5 per bushel in Pasdun Korale East. The price of coconuts was from Rs. 30 to Rs. 60 per thousand.

Remarks on harvest prospects : owing to the heavy rain during the month a good harvest cannot be expected.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 16.42 in. ; daily average, .52 in. There was heavy rain during the month, and the result was there were floods almost everywhere in this district.

Health of people : there have been 8 cases of enteric fever in Kalutara North, and it is understood that the infection has been brought from the General Hospital by an employé there. There have been some cases of dysentery in the totamunes.

Health of cattle : good. There was one case supposed to be rinderpest, but the disease did not spread.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala fields are ripening. Maha cultivation has commenced.

Dry grain cultivation : yala chenas are being harvested in Udunuwara, and maturing in Harispattu.

Maha : there has been no cultivation.

Prospect of coconut cultivation : flowering has been good, except in Uda Dumbara. The estimated produce during the month is, Yatinuwara, 26,000 ; Tumpane, 17,000 ; Harispattu, 40,000 ; Pata Hewaheta, 491,025. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Rainfall : there was a sufficient rainfall during the month.

Health of people : good, except in Pata Dumbara where a few cases of chickenpox prevailed.

Health of cattle : good.
