WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha: fields are being prepared for the maha cultivation. Yala: the plants are thriving well, but in some parts of Alutkuru Korale South and Siyane Korale West they were under water, owing to continual rain.

Dry grain: nil, excepting in Hewagam korale, Siyane Korale West, and Siyane Korale East where the kurakkan plants are thriving well.

Other products: (a) prospects of coconuts are satisfactory; (b) oranges, pineapples, breadfruits, and jak can be obtained; and (c) vegetables can be had at moderate prices.
