## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 1915.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala: the paddy is ripe and is fit for harvesting. Maha: fields are being prepared for cultivation.

Dry grain: kurakkan has been sown in some parts of the district.

Other products: (a) prospects of coconuts satisfactory, excepting in Siyane Korale West and Alutkuru Korale South, where they have been affected by the drought; (b) fruits, such as orange, jak, pineapple, and breadfruit, are scarce; (c) vegetables can be had at moderate prices.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 4 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs 25 to Rs. 50 per 1,000.

Harvest prospects: satisfactory.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants: there were 15 cases of chickenpox and 3 cases of smallpox; the latter occurred in Hewagam korale, Siyane Korale East, and the Colombo Mudaliyar's division.

Health of cattle: good, but there were a few cases of rinderpest in Siyane Korale East.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the crop of the yala harvest was being reaped in some parts, the dry weather being very favourable to the harvesting operations.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: vegetables and fruits were very scarce in the district. There was not much yam cultivation in Pasdun Korale West. Flowering of coconuts was fair, and the month's crop was estimated at 3,101,000.

Prices of staple products: price of imported rice was from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel, and country rice was Rs. 5 per bushel in Pasdun Korale East. The price of coconuts was from Rs. 30 to Rs. 60 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects: owing to incessant rain during July it was supposed that the paddy crop would be ruined, but it did not turn out to be so, and a fairly good yield is expected.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 1.24 in.; daily average, .04 in.

Health of people: good in Rayigam korale, Pasdun Korale East and West. In totamunes 3 cases of plague occurred at Hirana, Alubomulla, and Mestiya, respectively. The patients at Alubomulla and Mestiya died. There was a case of smallpox at Molligoda, and the patient is convalescing. There were several cases of dysentery, fever, and chickenpox.

Health of cattle: good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation: yala fields are being harvested, except in Tumpane and Uda Dumbara, where the fields are blossoming. Maha fields are being sown.

Dry grain cultivation: yala chenas are harvested. Maha cultivation is not begun yet.

Prospects of coconut cultivation: flowering has been fair. The estimated coconut crop during the month is Yatinuwara, 28,000; Tumpane, 15,000; Harispattu, 40,000; Pata Hewaheta, 470,000. The crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Prices of staple articles: rice, Rs. 5.25 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1.50 to Re. 1.87 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per 100.

There has been sufficient rain during the month.

Health of people: satisfactory.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

##### NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall: Nuwara Eliya towns 7.06 in.

Paddy: yala cultivation fields in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane have young plants. Kotmale fields are being sown.

Dry grains: chenas in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane are being cleared.

Health of population: good. There are a few cases of fever in Gangapalate korale of Uda Hewaheta.

Health of cattle: good.
