Two cases of human plague have occurred since my last announcement. One was on May 26, at Kochchikadde, and the other on June 10, in Sea street. Both cases were fatal, the one being septicemic, the other bubonic in character. Only one plague infected rat has been discovered. It was caught in 5th Cross street on June 8. So far this year, there have been 35 cases of plague among human beings. Last year the total was 213. You will also be pleased to hear that the recent epidemic of smallpox is over and that there has been no case since

May 26 last.

Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman—(a) With regard to the Special Meeting of the Municipal Council held at noon on Thursday, the 10th instant.
