MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, June 25, 1915.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated June 18, 1915.

Present.— Mr. R. W. Byrde, Chairman; Mr. C. P. Dias; Major A. W. de Wilton; the Hon. Mr. R. S. Templeton; Mr. L. B. Fernando; Mr. N. H. M. Abdul Cader; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. L. de Mel; Mr. E. G. Jayewardene; Dr. D. P. Banajee; Dr. E. V. Ratnam; Dr. W. P. Rodrigo; the Hon. Mr. T. H. Chapman; Mr. J. A. Perera; Mr. T. L. Villiers; Mr. C. H. Wellard; and Dr. G. J. Rutherford.

1. The Minutes of the General Meeting of May 26, 1915, having been previously printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of Council, were taken as read.

Resolved that the Minutes of the General Meeting of May 26, 1915, be confirmed.

2. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman read the following—

Statement re Plague.

Two cases of human plague have occurred since my last announcement. One was on May 26, at Kochehikadde, and the other on June 10, in Sea street. Both cases were fatal, the one being septicemic, the other bubonic in character.

Only one plague infected rat has been discovered. It was caught in 5th Cross street on June 8. So far this year, there have been 35 cases of plague among human beings. Last year the total was 213.

You will also be pleased to hear that the recent epidemic of smallpox is over and that there has been no case since May 26 last.

3. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman—(a) With regard to the Special Meeting of the Municipal Council held at noon on Thursday, the 10th instant. If it is true that he was attended by Mr. Allnutt, one of the Additional Police Magistrates of Colombo, and if so, whether he will be good enough to tell this Council for what purpose he was so attended. (b) Why the Minutes of that meeting have not been printed and circulated yet and when he will do so. The Chairman replied to the effect that no Special Meeting of the Council had been held.

4. Dr. Rodrigo had given notice that he would move that "Papers in connection with that Meeting be tabled."

The Chairman stated that as there was no Meeting there were no papers and disallowed the motion being put.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved that the Council do go into Committee to consider items Nos. 5 to 8 on the agenda. Mr. L. B. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

(Council in Committee.)

- (2) To consider an application from P. Jeremias to open a meat stall at No. 86, Jampettah street. Recommended that P. Jeremias be granted a license for No. 86, Jampettah street, if the premises are approved of by the Medical Officer of Health.

- (9) To sanction three months' full pay leave, on urgent private affairs, to Mr. C. Bond, Inspector, Waterworks Department.—Recommended.
- (11) To consider the letters from the Colombo Commercial Company *re* (1) the present and (2) future supplies of cement. Recommended that the proposal of the Commercial Company contained in their letter of May 26, 1915, be granted, and that their offer contained in their letter of May 19, 1915, be accepted.
- (13) To sanction the removal of the Queen's Statue to Gordon Gardens. Recommended that the Council approve of the removal of the Statue to the new site in the Gordon Gardens.
- (14) To consider an application for leave, till the end of the War, from the City Sanitation Engineer. Recommended that the request of Mr. Cox be not granted.
- (16) To consider the question of re-engaging the services of Mr. H. J. Donkin, Assistant Engineer, Mechanical, after the expiry of his present agreement. Recommended that Mr. Donkin be informed that the Council will be prepared to give him permanent employment, but cannot settle the terms at present. One of the conditions will be that he must pass a test examination in Sinhalese or Tamil within a stipulated period.
- (17) To sanction the proposed street lines for Pamankada—Cotta road.—Recommended that the streets lines as laid down be adopted.
- (18) To consider the question of water service to premises No. 821/128-29, St. Joseph's lane, Wellawatta. Recommended that the applicant be permitted to clean the pipes on his entering into a bond to connect with the 3-in. main when laid.
- (19) To consider the application from Mr. D. D. W. Samarakone, to be placed on the list of approved Contractors, and the question whether the firm of Messrs. Samarakone Brothers should be permitted to continue on the list of Contractors for waterworks fittings. Recommended that the firm of Samarakone Brothers be taken off the list of contractors for waterworks fittings.

Dr. E. V. Ratnam, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo, Mr. J. A. Perera, and Major A. W. de Wilton also spoke in favour of the motion.

With reference to item No. 19, Dr. E. V. Ratnam moved that the consideration of the matter be postponed and that the papers be circulated. Dr. W. P. Rodrigo seconded.—Carried.

Resolved that the remaining items of the above recommendations of the combined Committees on Municipal Works and Finance be adopted.
