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NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following Specification has been accepted:—

"Improvements to sifters and strainers."

Abstract.—The inventor states:—

The object of my invention is to provide a more efficient buckle for clamping the straining material to the type of sifter and strainer described in Patent No. 1,202, dated November 10, 1911, or to any other sifter or strainer of a similar kind.

My invention consists of a buckle attached to a flexible metal band by means of which it is possible to apply whatever strain may be necessary for firmly clamping the straining material to the vessel which holds the matter to be strained.

The buckle consists of two parts which are fixed to opposite ends of a metal band of the appropriate length.

One of the parts consists of a circular pivot bar, figure 6 in the drawings, about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in length, $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch in diameter in the middle one-third of the circular pivot bar, and $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch in diameter at each of the two ends. The middle of the circular pivot bar is recessed to the depth of about $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch—the recess being about $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch in diameter. This circular pivot bar is fixed to one end of a metal band in such a manner as to leave the middle one-third of it in which the recess exists exposed, while the two ends are encircled by two loops in which they can work round.

The other part is made up of three pieces of wire loop, figure 3, bent as shown in the drawings, a screw with a ball head and spigot end, figure 5, as shown in the drawings, and a tapped bar, figure 7, with a screw cut in the middle of it, into which the screw is introduced. The two ends of the loop are introduced into the tapped bar at each end of that bar and is fixed to the other end of the metal band as shown in the drawings, figure 1.

The two parts as above described when assembled form the buckle described in the drawings.

The claim is:—

In sifters and strainers a buckle consisting of a circular pivot bar recessed in the middle, a wire loop and tapped bar pierced in the middle to take a screw, and a screw with ball head and spigot end, all substantially as described and illustrated.

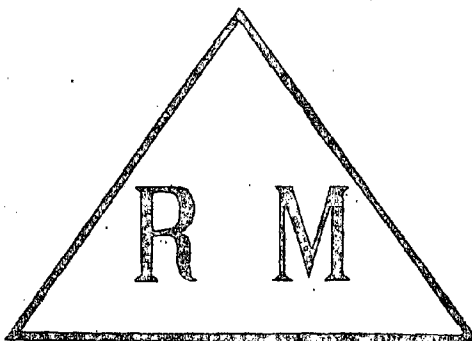

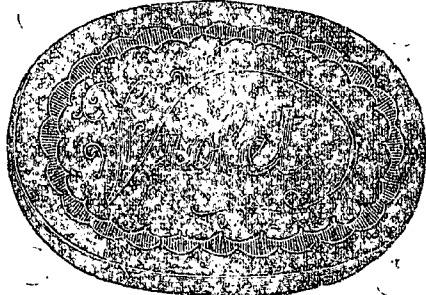

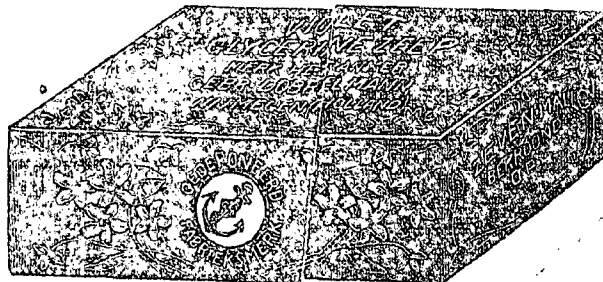
