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## PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

“THE NECESSARIES OF WAR EXPORTATION ORDINANCE, NO. 19 OF 1914.”

In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ROBERT CHALMERS, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

ROBERT CHALMERS.

WHEREAS it is desirable further to amend Our Proclamation in pursuance of the said “The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914,” dated the 9th day of April, 1915, and published in the *Government Gazette* No. 6,709 of the 16th April, 1915:

Know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, do hereby amend the said Proclamation by prohibiting the exportation of the under-mentioned articles to Spain.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Sixth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fifteen.
