GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

IT is hereby notified that, under Section 11 (a) of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, as amended by Ordinance No. 5 of 1914, the Legislative Council did, as its Session on September 30, 1915, pass the following Resolution, which has been duly sanctioned by His Excellency the Governor:—

That this Council resolves that from and after October 1, 1915, on the exportation of the following articles there shall be imposed the Customs Duties herein stated:—

Tea, per 100 lb.	1 50
Rubber, per 100 lb.	7 50
Cacao, per 100 lb.	1 50
Cardamoms, per 100 lb.	7 50
Coconuts, fresh, per 1,000	2 0
Coconut, desiccated, per cwt.	0 70
Copra, per cwt.	0 40
Coconut Oil, per cwt.	0 75

It is further notified that the said Resolution has been duly submitted to, and sanctioned by, the Secretary of State for the Colonies, as required by Section 11 (b) of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, as amended by Ordinance No. 5 of 1914.
