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DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance exempting certain Churches from the operation of Ordinance No. 12 of 1846 and empowering the Synod of the Church of England in Ceylon to grant similar exemptions in other cases.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the following churches situated in different parts of the Island are at present governed by the Ordinance No. 12 of 1846, that is to say, Holy Trinity, Colombo; All Saints', Colombo; Holy Trinity, Nuwara Eliya; All Saints', Galle; St. John the Baptist, Kegalla; Holy Trinity, Pussellawa; Christ Church, Matale; and St. Clement's, Puttalam:

And whereas it is expedient to exempt certain of the said churches from the operation of the said Ordinance and to empower the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Church of England in Ceylon to exempt such other of the said churches as desire to be so exempt from the operation of the said Ordinance:

Be it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Episcopal Churches (Exemption) Ordinance, No. of 1915."

Certain churches declared exempt.

2 The churches mentioned in the schedule hereto are and they are hereby declared exempt from the operation of the Ordinance No. 12 of 1846 and any amending Ordinance thereof.

Standing Committee of the Synod empowered to exempt churches.

3 If at any time after the passing of this Ordinance any of the afore-mentioned churches which have not been included in the schedule to this Ordinance desire to be exempted from the operation of the said Ordinance No. 12 of 1846, the trustees of any such church may apply to the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Church of England in Ceylon to be exempted from the operation of the said Ordinance No. 12 of 1846, and the said Standing Committee is hereby empowered to grant such exemption by the issue of a certificate signed by the Bishop of Colombo in the form set out in the schedule to this Ordinance, and on the issue of such certificate the said church shall be exempt from the operation of the said Ordinance.

Provided always that no such application shall be entertained unless the said Standing Committee shall be satisfied that two-thirds of the seat-holders of the said church present at three consecutive annual meetings of the congregation have voted in favour of such application.

Churches exempted and hereafter to be exempted to vest in the incorporated trustees of the Church of England in trust for the use of the Church of England in Ceylon.

4 The churches hereby exempted, and also such churches as shall hereafter be exempted under this Ordinance, and all property belonging or appertaining thereto, shall vest absolutely in the incorporated trustees of the Church of England in Ceylon, in trust and to and for the use of the Church of England in Ceylon, subject to the provisions of the Ordinance No. 6 of 1885 and any amending Ordinance thereof.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to exempt certain churches from the operation of Ordinance No. 12 of 1846, many of the provisions of which have become obsolete and unworkable, and to empower the Synod of the Church of England in Ceylon to exempt other churches desiring to be so exempted.
