# WESTERN PROVINCE.

# COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha: the paddy plants are thriving. Yala: the crop is now being gathered.

Dry grain: nil. Excepting in Siyane Korale Eest and Hapitigam korale where kurakkan and amu are flourishing. Other products: (a) coconuts prospects are satisfactory; (b) fruit, such as oranges, pineapples, and jak, are scerce;

(c) vegetables are dear.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at from Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at

from Rs. 25 to Rs. 50 per 1,000. Reinfall: sufficient rain fell during the month.

Harvest prospects: a good harvest is expected.

Health of inhabitants: setisfactory, except there have been a few cases of smallpox in Siyane Korale East and Hewagam korale, some cases of chickenpox and dysentery in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division, Siyane Korale East, Hewagam korale, Alutkuru Korale South, and Salpiti korale, and also a case of plague at Nawaja, in the Colombo Mudaliyar's

Health of cattle: very satisfactory.

## KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: reaping of the yala harvest was finished during the month, and preparation of the fields for the maha was also commenced during the month.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: vegetables and fruit were very scarce in the Rayigam korale and Pasdun Korale West, but there was a fair supply in the totamunes. There was not much of yam cultivation in the Pasdun Korale West. Flowering of coconuts was fair, and the month's crop was estimated at 2,565,000.

Prices of staple products: price of imported rice was from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel; that of country rice, Rs. 5 per bushel in Pasdun Korale East. The price of coconuts was from Rs. 30 to Rs. 55 per 1,000.

Remarks on harvest prospects: the harvest was good, the dry weather helping the people to collect the paddy and There were heavy showers of rain in the totamunes and in Pasdun Korale West.

Rainfall in Kalutara: total, 10.81 in.; daily average, .36 in.

Health of people: good in Pasdun Korale East, Pasdun Korale West, and Rayigam korale. In the totamunes were 13 cases of dysentery, 13 cases of contagious fever, and 5 cases of chickenpox.

Health of cattle: good.
