ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1915.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall: Nuwara Eliya town, 3·38 in.
Paddy: Walapane—yala crops are being gathered. Uda Hewaheta, some fields are being prepared for maha cultivation and some are blossoming. Kotmale—transplanting.
Dry grain: chenas are ready for sowing.
Health of population: fair. There are a few cases of chickenpox in Kohoka korale of Uda Hewaheta.
Health of cattle: good.
Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel; kurakkan Rs. 2·50 per bushel; Indian corn, Re. 1·25 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 6 to Rs. 7·50 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 6 to Rs. 6·50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6 to Rs. 8 per 100 nuts.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Fields were being sown for the maha harvest.
Dry grain is cultivated in the district only on a small scale.
Coconut, tea, cinnamon, rubber, and vegetables were the general products. The estimated coconut crop was 11,225,778 nuts.
Coast rice varied from Rs. 4·18 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy varied from Re. 1·50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; fine grain varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 per 1,000.
The weather was generally dry during the month, but towards the end it was very wet.
