## Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Galagawahenyaya (exclusive of the footpaths passing through the land), situate in the village of Nagolla, in the Mahagalboda Egoda korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
