

No. 6,738 of September 4, 1915.

It is in all cases essential that the bill of lading or a certified copy thereof should be on board every vessel sailing

with cargo from this port.

Ship agents will therefore be required to produce at the Customs a copy of the manifest, with corresponding bills of lading, before clearance is issued.

It should be clearly understood that no form of consignment will secure to vessels immunity from the belligerent right of visit, search, and detention, whatever the country or port from which they may have shipped the goods they are carrying and whatever the description of these goods; compliance with the following recommendations in respect of bills of lading will, however, minimize the risk of delay, and will therefore be in the interest both of the ship and of the goods:

the goods:—
