MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, August 27, 1915.

The Council met this day at 3 p.m., pursuant to notice dated August 20, 1915.

Present.—Mr. R. W. Byrde, Chairman; Mr. N. H. M. Abdul Cader; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. L. de Mel; Mr. E. G. Jayewardene; Dr. D. P. Banajee; Dr. E. V. Ratnam; Dr. W. P. Rodrigo; Mr. J. A. Perera; Mr. T. L. Villiers; Mr. F. R. Senanayake; Captain P. W. Mathew, R.A.M.C.; Mr. C. H. Wellard; the Hon. Dr. G. J. Rutherford; Mr. W. C. S. Ingles; and Mr. G. Waddell.

1. The Minutes of the General Meeting of July 30, 1915, having been previously printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of Council, were taken as read.

Resolved that the Minutes of the General Meeting of July 30, 1915, be confirmed.

The Chairman, with leave of Council, moved that the Council do place on record its grateful appreciation of the able assistance rendered by the Hon. Mr. R. S. Templeton, Surveyor-General, in the deliberations of the Council and on the different Committees on which he has served during his seven years of membership.

The Chairman read a letter from Mr. C. P. Dias, expressing his appreciation of the services rendered by Mr. Templeton to the Council and warmly supporting the motion. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried unanimously.

2. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman read the following—

Statement re Plague.

As I foreshadowed at the last meeting there has been a recrudescence of plague. Since that meeting there have been 22 cases of human plague, which have occurred in different parts of the city.

The flea index, which was at its highest for the fortnight from July 24 to August 7, has fallen again, so that we may reasonably hope that there will be fewer cases this coming month.

3. Pursuant to notice, Mr. H. L. de Mel moved that the Chairman do obtain for the information of members of this Council the number of registered habitual criminals at each of the Police Stations in Colombo. Mr. N. H. M. Abdul Cader seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman stated that on the receipt of the above motion he had applied to the Inspector-General of Police for the information, and at the latter's request the Superintendent of Police, Colombo, had furnished the return, which the Chairman read as follows:—

4. Pursuant to notice, Mr. H. L. de Mel moved that in the interests of public health a proper system of regular vaccination and compulsory re-vaccination once in four or five years is essential, and that with a view to carrying out a complete scheme of vaccination in this city and throughout the Island, Government be requested to so amend the law (Ordinance No. 20 of 1886) relating to vaccination. The Hon. Dr. G. J. Rutherford seconded.

The Chairman, in speaking to the motion, reviewed the sections of the Ordinance dealing with the question and quoted from a report of the Medical Officer of Health.

Dr. W. P. Rodrigo moved, as an amendment, that the matter be referred to the Special Committee on smallpox which is at present sitting. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.

Dr. E. V. Ratnam supported the amendment.

Mr. De Mel, with the consent of the seconder, agreed to the addition to his motion of the words "and that the matter be referred to the Special Committee on smallpox which is now sitting."

The motion, as amended, namely, that the question be referred to the Special Committee, was put to the meeting and carried unanimously.

5. Pursuant to notice, Mr. E. G. Jayewardene—in presenting a petition from M. M. Magathum Pulle, stating his inability to enter into a lease, for which he had tendered, of the Municipal land at Panchikawatta opposite to the Maradana Railway Station by reason of his shops having been looted at the Wesak riots, in consequence of which he has been reduced to poverty and consequent inability to carry out his tender, and praying that the deposit he has made be not forfeited, but be refunded to him—moved that the prayer of the petitioner be granted. Dr. E. V. Ratnam seconded.

The Chairman recommended that, in the circumstances, the Council should waive its claim to the deposit.

Dr. W. P. Rodrigo raised an objection to the words "Wesak riots" and the mover consented to the substitution of the word "recent" for "Wesak."

Mr. T. L. Villiers asked for information with regard to the financial status of the tenderer at the time the tender was made and moved, as an amendment, that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee for consideration. Dr. W. P. Rodrigo seconded.—Carried.

6. Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that the Council do go into Committee to consider items Nos. 6 and 7 on the agenda. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

(Council in Committee.)

The following extract from the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Law and General Subjects and extracts from the combined Standing Committee on Municipal Works and Finance and of the Finance Committee, having been previously printed and circulated, were laid before the Council in Committee:—

Extract from the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Law and General Subjects of August 18, 1915.

(5) To consider an application to re-build a wall on premises No. 47, 3rd Division, Maradana, in relation to the proposed street lines in Maradana.

Recommended that the application be allowed on the owner entering into a notarial deed not to claim compensation for the portion re-built on the land being taken over to form the public street.

Resolution.

Resolved that the above recommendation be adopted.

Extracts from the Minutes of the combined Standing Committee on Municipal Works and Finance of August 20, 1915

(4) To reconsider (a) Applications for leave, with permission to serve with His Majesty's forces during the War, from Messrs. C. H. Kilmister, T. B. Stewart, and H. J. Donkin of the Works Department; (b) a letter from Mr. N. M. Ingram, Works Engineer, notifying that he may be called upon to offer his services in a military capacity at a later date.—Recommended that leave be granted to Mr. Donkin, namely, 3 months' full-pay leave and six months' half-pay, and that he be granted further leave without pay till the end of the War, provided he has joined some branch of His Majesty's Forces.

(6) To sanction the payment of the allowance of Rs. 35 per mensem, with effect from June 24, 1915, available from Mr. C. Bond's salary, to Mr. F. P. van Houten, Surveyor, Main Pipe Line Works.—Recommended.

(8) To consider the charges against Inspector R. H. G. Oorloff, City Sanitation Department.—Recommended that Mr. Oorloff be dismissed.

(9) To consider an application from Mr. E. Cadman for permission to enclose the reservation for the scavenging lanes and also the site reserved for the Fire Station and up to the latrine at Panchikawatta.—Recommended that Mr. Cadman be permitted to enclose the reservations and the land up to the latrine on payment of an extra amount of Rs. 5 a month.

Resolution.

Resolved that the above recommendations be adopted.

Extracts from the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Finance of August 20, 1915.

- (2) To fix the upset price for the sale of premises No. 1,270/67, New Moor street.—Recommended that if the arrears of taxes and all costs are paid before December 31, 1915, the premises be transferred to the applicant, A. M. M. Abdul Cader, after notice to the former owner, Mazoor.
- (3) To sanction a supplementary vote of Rs. 6,000 to meet the expenditure incurred on account of the Wesak riots.—Recommended that a vote of Rs. 6,000 be granted.
- (4) To sanction (1) The renewal of the lease of the old Toll Station at Grandpass to Messrs. Delmege, Forsyth and Co. for a further term of 5 years from January 1, 1916; and (2) to fix the rental for the lease.—Recommended that the lease be renewed for a further term of 5 years at a rental of Rs 50 a month.
- (5) To sanction the sale, by public auction, for valuable consideration, of premises No. 1,469/240A, Madampitiya—land vested in the Council, having been sold for arrears of taxes.—Recommended that the land be sold by public auction at an upset price of Rs. 500.
- (6) To provide an amount of Rs. 24 in the current Supplementary Budget to meet the full salary of Stock Inspector A. M. H. Dias, the provision made in the Budget being, through a clerical error, insufficient by this amount.—Recommended.
- (7) To sanction the re-vote of Rs. 202·34 under H. 7 of 1914-15—Uniforms.—Recommended.
- (9) To sanction the continuance of half-pay and full allowance to Miss Mary Ponnammal, Health Visitor, Public Health Department, until further orders.—Recommended that she be allowed to draw half-pay and full allowance.
- (10) To sanction a supplementary vote of Rs. 4,000 under Estimate H (a) 4—Prevention of Infectious Diseases.—Recommended.
- (11) To sanction a re-vote of Rs. 260·50 under vote D. 5—Uniforms.—Recommended.
- (12) To sanction a gratuity of Rs. 45 to the widow of Don Dines Appu, a coolly employed at the Cattle Mart and Quarantine Station.—Recommended.

With reference to item No. 3, it was resolved that the word "recent" be substituted for the word "Wesak." Resolved that the recommendations, as amended, be adopted.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that the Council do resume, and that the resolutions of Council in Committee be adopted. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman, in Council, moved that the recommendations of the Council in Committee, as amended, be adopted. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

8. To consider the Chairman's Administration Report in terms of section 102 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1910.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that, in terms of section 102 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1910, the Chairman's Administration Report be forwarded to His Excellency the Governor in due course. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

9. The Chairman to move the appointment of members to the Establishment Committee and the Commission Committee in the places of the Hon. Mr. R. S. Templeton and the Hon. Mr. T. H. Chapman, who have resigned.

The Chairman moved that Mr. W. C. S. Ingles and Mr. G. W. Waddell be appointed to the Establishment Committee and the Commission Committee in the places of the Hon. Mr. R. S. Templeton and the Hon. Mr. T. H. Chapman, who have resigned. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

10. The Chairman to move the appointment of a member to the Special Committee on Drainage Works in place of the Hon. Mr. T. H. Chapman, resigned.

The Chairman moved that Mr. G. W. Waddell be appointed a member of the Special Committee on Drainage Works in place of the Hon. Mr. T. H. Chapman, resigned. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

11-12. Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that the following items on the agenda, namely, Nos. 11 and 12, be adopted. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

(11) To sanction excess leave of 27 days over 42 days granted to Mr. C. Silva, Clerk, Works Department, owing to ill-health.

(12) To sanction excess leave of 97 days over 42 days granted to Mr. N. Schokman, Sub-Inspector, Public Health Department, owing to ill-health.
