MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, August 27, 1915.

THE Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated August 20, 1915.

Present.—Mr. R. W. Byrde, Chairman; Mr. N. H. M. Abdul Cader; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. L. de Mel; Mr. F. G. Jayewardene; Dr. D. P. Banajee; Dr. E. V. Ratnam; Dr. W. P. Rodrigo; Mr. J. A. Perera; Mr. T. L. Villiers; Mr. F. R. Senanayake; Captain P. W. Mathew, R.A.M.C.; Mr. C. H. Wellard; the Hon. Dr. G. J. Rutherford; Mr. W. C. S. Ingles; and Mr. G. Waddell.

1. The Minutes of the General Meeting of July 30, 1915, having been previously printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of Council, were taken as read.
 Resolved that the Minutes of the General Meeting of July 30, 1915, be confirmed.
 The Chairman, with leave of Council, moved that the Council do place on record its grateful appreciation of the able assistance rendered by the Hon. Mr. R. S. Templeton, Surveyor-General, in the deliberations of the Council and on the different Committees on which he has served during his seven years of membership.
 The Chairman read a letter from Mr. C. P. Dias, expressing his appreciation of the services rendered by Mr. Templeton to the Council and warmly supporting the motion. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried unanimously.

Statement ro Plague.

As I foreshadowed at the last meeting there has been a recrudescence of plague. Since that meeting there have been 22 cases of human plague, which have occurred in different parts of the city. The flea index, which was at its highest for the fortnight from July 24 to August 7, has fallen again, so that we may

reasonably hope that there will be fewer cases this coming month.

4. Pursuant to notice, Mr. H. L. de Mel moved that in the interests of public health a proper system of regular veccination and compulsory re-vaccination once in four or five years is essential, and that with a view to carrying out a complete scheme of vaccination in this city and throughout the Island, Government be requested to so amont the law (Ordinance No. 20 of 1886) relating to vaccination. The Hon. Dr. G. J. Rutherford seconded. The Chairman, in speaking to the motion, reviewed the sections of the Ordinance dealing with the question and quoted from a report of the Medical Officer of Health. Dr. W. P. Rodrigo moved, as an amendment, that the matter be referred to the Special Committee on smallpox

which is at present sitting. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded. Dr. E. V. Ratnam supported the amendment.

Mr. De Mel, with the consent of the seconder, agreed to the addition to his motion of the words " and that the matter be referred to the Special Committee on smallpox which is now sitting." The motion, as amended, namely, that the question be referred to the Special Committee, was put to the meeting

and carried unanimously

5. Pursuant to notice, Mr. E. G. Jayewardene—in presenting a petition from M. M. Magathum Pulle, stating his . inability to enter into a lease, for which he had tendered, of the Municipal land at Panchikawatta opposite to the Maradana Railway Station by reason of his shops having been looted at the Wesak riots, in consequence of which he has been reduced The Chairman recommended that, in the circumstances, the Council should waive its claim to the deposit.
Dr. W. P. Rodrigo raised an objection to the words "Wesak riots" and the mover consented to the substitution
of the word "recent" for "Wesak."

Mr. T. L. Villiers asked for information with regard to the financial status of the tenderer at the time the tender was made and moved, as an amendment, that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee for consideration. Dr. W. P. Rodrigo seconded.—Carried.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that the Council do go into Committee to consider items Nos. 6 and 7 on the agenda Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

Extract from the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Law and General Subjects of August 18, 1915.
