PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir Robert Chalmers, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Vice-Admiral of Ceylon.

K NOW Ye that We, the Governor and Vice-Admiral of Ceylon, being satisfied thereof by information received by Us, do hereby declare that war has broken out between His Most Gracious Majesty and the King of Bulgaria.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Eighteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fifteen..

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ROBERT CHALMERS, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

NOW Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, do hereby proclaim that His Majesty the King has issued a Proclamation declaring that all Proclamations and Orders in Council issued since the commencement of the present war relating to the German Emperor, his subjects and his dominions (except the Order in Council with reference to the granting of days of grace to enemy shipping, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 6,639 of August 5, 1914), shall apply to the King of Bulgaria, his subjects and his dominions, in the same manner as if the same were therein named:

We, therefore, the said Governor, do hereby notify that the said Proclamation of His Majesty the King is in force in the Colony of Ceylon, and do call upon His Majesty's subjects and all other persons being in the said Colony to govern themselves accordingly.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Nineteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fifteen.
