## PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

## No. 1 of 1916.

An Ordinance to amend "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914."

R. E. STUBBS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Necessaries of War Exportation (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 1 of 1916."
- Addition of new section 2 A.
- 2 After section 2 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be added, and shall be numbered 2 A:

Principal Collector of Customs may issue licenses subject to conditions.

- 2 A. (1) The Principal Collector of Customs may issue licenses, subject to such conditions as may be therein contained, authorizing the exportation of any goods subject to prohibition under this Ordinance to a particular person or place, or to a particular person at a particular place named in the license, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to goods shipped in accordance with such license.
- (2) In any such case the name of the person or place, or both, as the case may be, shall be inserted in all licenses, bills of lading, manifests, and other documents relating to the goods, and if this requirement is not complied with as regards any document, the person by whom or on whose behalf the document is made out shall, if he be the exporter of the goods, be deemed to have exported the goods without a license, and if any other person, shall be guilty of an offence and be liable to a fine of one thousand rupees.
- (3) Any person to whom any such license has been issued who shall commit any breach of any of the conditions of the license shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable to the same punishment as if he had exported the goods in question without a license.
