In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

WHEREAS it is desirable further to amend Our Proclamation issued in pursuance of "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914," dated the 17th day of December, 1915, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 31st day of December, 1915 (as already amended by Our Proclamations dated the 6th and 12th January, 1916, published in the *Government Gazettes* Nos. 6,768 and 6,769 of the 7th and 13th January, respectively):

Know Ye that We, the Officer Administering the Government, in pursuance of the said "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914," do hereby amend Our Proclamation of the 17th December, 1915, aforesaid in the manner set out in the schedule hereto, and do call upon His Majesty's subjects and all other persons being in the said Colony to govern themselves accordingly.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Fifth day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Sixteen.

1. The following item shall be inserted immediately after item No. 3, and numbered 3 A :—
 - 3 A. Bladders, casings, and sausage skins.
2. Under item No. 14—
 - (a) The following heading shall be inserted immediately after the heading "Coca, &c." :—
Colchicum and its preparations.
 - (b) The following heading shall be inserted immediately after the heading "Bicarbonate" classed under Potash salts :—
Bichromate of soda.
3. The following item shall be inserted immediately after the item No. 26, and numbered 26 A :—
 - 26 A. Fats and oils, all animal and vegetable (other than essential oils).
4. Under item No. 52—
 - (a) The following heading shall be inserted immediately after the heading "Hoop iron" :—
Iron, hæmatite pig.
 - (b) The following heading shall be inserted immediately after the heading "Scheelite" :—
Scrap iron and steel smelting.
5. The following item shall be inserted immediately after item No. 60, and numbered 60 A :—
 - 60 A. Pepper.
6. The following item shall be inserted immediately after item No. 82, and numbered 82 A :—
 - 82 A. Solid drawn steel tubes.
7. The following item shall be inserted immediately after item No. 91, and numbered 91 A :—
 - 91 A. Vegetable fibres, all such, and yarns made therefrom (not including linen thread) as are not at present prohibited to be exported to any destination.
8. The following item shall be inserted immediately after item No. 95, and numbered 95 A :—
 - 95 A. Wireless telegraphs, material for.

In Schedule B.

1. Item No. 7 shall be deleted.
2. Under item No. 16 the heading "Bichromate of soda" shall be deleted.
3. Item No. 28 shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor :—
28. Food stuffs and feeding stuffs, and the raw materials thereof.
4. Item No. 49 shall be deleted.
5. Under item No. 46 the heading "Iron, hæmatite pig," shall be deleted.
6. Item No. 59 shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor :—
59. Telegraphs (other than wireless) and telephones, material for.

SCHEDULE D.

To all Foreign Countries other than France, Russia (except through Baltic Ports), and Italy.

All oleaginous nuts, seeds, and products, including castor beans, coconuts, copra, cotton seed, ground nuts (Arachides), linseed, palm kernels, rape seed, sesame seed, soya beans.
