#### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1916.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

#### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha season is now over. Yala : fields are being cultivated for the yala season.

Dry grains : in Siyane Korale West and Hewagam korale preparations are being made for the cultivation of kurak. kan only, and in Siyane Korale East preparations are being made for the cultivation of kurakkan, el-paddy, and amu.

Other products : (a) flowering prospects of coconuts are satisfactory, (b) vegetables can be had at moderate prices, (c) fruits are rather scarce.

Price of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 7 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 50 to Rs. 60 per thousand.

Harvest prospect : satisfactory. Rainfall : there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants : good ; excepting a few cases of chickenpox, enteric fever, and malarial fever which is prevail. ing in an epidemic form in almost all the villages bordering the banks of the Kelani-ganga and Wak-oya, in Hewagam korale. Health of cattle : satisfactory.

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala cultivation was brought to a close during the month. Dry grain : nil.

Other products : (a) there was a fair supply of vegetables and fruits in the totamunes and Rayigam korale. In Pasdun korale they were scarce. In the totamunes and Pasdun Korale West there was also a fair supply of jak. (b) The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 2,540,000 nuts.

Price of staple products : Coast rice, Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; country rice, in Pasdun Korale East, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : there is no harvest in the near future. Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 18.22 in. ; average, .60 in.

Health of people : two cases of septicæmic plague occurred and ended fatally in the totamunes. Fever is prevalent district. There were many cases of chickenpox and dysentery in the totamunes. A large number of people are in the district. suffering from ulcers in Pasdun Korale West.

Health of cattle : good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

#### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala fields are being ploughed. Maha : nil.

Dry grain cultivation : yala chenas are being sown in Harispattu. Maha : nil.

Prospect of coconut cultivation : flowering cf coconuts has been fair, except in Pata Dumbara and Uda Dumbara. The estimated crop during the month is as follows : Tumpane, 15,000; Yatinuwara, 23,000; Harispattu, 40,000; Pata Hewaheta, 500,000. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Prices of staple articles : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 8 per 100.

Rainfall : there has been sufficient rainfall during the month, except in Pata Dumbara.

Health of people : sore eyes, measles, fever, and chickenpox prevailed in scme villages.

Health of cattle : there was an outbreak of rinderpest in Pata Dumbara, which was speedily checked.
