ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1916.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season : the plants are under water owing to the recent heavy rains, but in Hewagam korale and Salpiti korale they are thriving well.

Dry grains : in Siyane Korale West, Siyane Korale East, and Hewagam korale kurakkan have been cultivated.

Other products : (a) flowering prospects of coconuts are fair ; (b) vegetables are rather scarce ; (c) fruits, such as oranges, pineapples, mangoes, and jak fruits, are obtainable.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 45 to Rs. 55 per thousand.

Harvest prospect : fair.

Rainfall : there were many heavy showers of rain during the month, followed by huge floods, consequently lowlying villages, gardens, and roads were submerged, and in Alutkuru Korale South several houses in Hendala and Dandugama peruwas have collapsed.

1. The timber will be put up in lots to suit buyers, and prices should be bid per lot.

2. The highest bids will be accepted for the different lots, subject to the approval or disapproval of the Conservator of Forests. The highest bidder will be required by the officer conducting the sale to sign the sale book kept for the purpose directly a lot has been knocked down to him.

3. Payment of 25 per cent. of the successful bid to be made at time of sale if so required.

4. No timber shall be removed before the payment of the full price bid, and all timber sold must be removed from the spot within fourteen days of date of notification of acceptance by the Conservator of Forests of such bid, and will be at the risk of the purchasers until removed. 5. Should any person to whom a lot is knocked down refuse to take it over at the full price bid, or refuse or fail to sign the sale book and pay 25 per cent. of his bid when so required, or refuse or fail to pay the full purchase amount or balance thereof, as the case may be, and to remove the timber within the time specified in clause 4 above, the lot will again be put up for auction and the original purchaser or bidder will be held liable for any loss to Government owing to a lower price being realized at the re-sale, while if an enhanced price is realized at such re-sale, he shall, however, have no claim to the profit which shall accrue to Government.

6. Agents bidding for others should produce a written authority from their principals.

6. The offers should either be deposited in the tender box in the Offices of the Assistant Conservator of Forests and the Conservator of Forests, or be sent by registered post.

7. The full amount of the offer must be paid by the tenderer within fourteen days of receiving notice in writing from the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Anuradhapura, that his offer has been accepted by the Conservator of Forests. Default herein shall involve forfeiture of the deposit mentioned in clause 3 above, and the defaulter will render himself liable to be included in the list of defaulting contractors precluded from having any concern in a Government contract.

8. No timber shall be removed from the forest before obtaining a removal permit.

9. All the pieces must be removed out of the forest mentioned in clause 1 above within three months from the date of payment, and any timber not so removed will revert to the Crown.

10. Should the purchaser or his employes cause any damage to trees in the forests or commit any forest offence, the purchaser shall be held liable to pay compensation for all such damage or loss, and on failure to pay he shall be liable to prosecution.

11. A sum of Rs. 100 must be deposited as security for the due observance of the foregoing conditions, the deposit being required to be made at the time of paying the purchase amount.
