#### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1916.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season: the plants are under water owing to the recent heavy rains, but in Hewagam korale and Salpiti korale they are thriving well.

Dry grains: in Siyane Korale West, Siyane Korale East, and Hewagam korale kurakkan have been cultivated. Other products: (a) flowering prospects of coconuts are fair; (b) vegetables are rather scarce; (c) fruits, such as oranges, pineapples, mangoes, and jak fruits, are obtainable.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 7 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 45 to Rs. 55 per thousand.

Harvest prospect: fair.

Rainfall: there were many heavy showers of rain during the month, followed by huge floods, consequently lowlying villages, gardens, and roads were submerged, and in Alutkuru Korale South several houses in Hendala and Dandugama peruwas have collapsed.

Health of inhabitants: good, except a few cases of chickenpox, enteric fever, and malarial fever, which is prevailing to a considerable extent in an epidemic form, particularly in the villages bordering Kelani river in Siyane Korale East.

Health of cattle: good.
