## ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

### SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1916.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

**Paddy:** the plants of the yala cultivation were damaged in some parts of the district by the recent floods. Those that survived the floods are thriving well.

**Dry grain:** nil.

**Other products:** (a) vegetables were scarce every where in the district. There was a fair supply of jak in all the korales. Yams were plentiful in Pasdun Korale East and West. Fruits were scarce in all the korales, except totamunes, where there was a fair supply. (b) The flowering of coconuts was good. (c) The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 2,665,000.

**Prices of staple products:** Coast rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel; country rice, in Pasdun Korale East, Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 nuts.

**Remarks on harvest prospects generally:** It is yet too early for an expression of definite opinion.

**Rainfall at Kalutara:** total, 41.20 in.; average, 1.32 in. In the korales, too, there was heavy rain resulting in floods.

**Health of people:** fever has been prevalent to some extent in all the korales. A fatal case of plague occurred in the totamunes, and 2 fatal cases of cholera in Pasdun Korale West. A few cases of chickenpox have been reported from the totamunes and Pasdun Korale West.

**Health of cattle:** good.

## Notice under "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912."

Excise Notification No. 52.

WHEREAS under section 17 of "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912," no person can sell any excisable article without a license from the Government Agent :

And whereas by Notification No. 51, published in the *Government Gazette* of June 16, 1916, no person can possess any cocaine—

- (a) Unless he holds licenses for the possession thereof in accordance with notifications issued by the Excise Commissioner in that behalf, and subject to the conditions of such licenses ; or
- (b) Except in the form of medicine duly obtained from a licensed retail dealer upon the prescription of a registered and qualified medical practitioner, or, for veterinary purposes only, from a qualified veterinary surgeon, which prescription shall not be repeated ; or
- (c) Unless such person be a Government Medical Officer or Government Apothecary who possesses cocaine belonging to Government entrusted to him in his capacity as such medical officer or apothecary, or an apothecary or dispenser in the employment of a Municipality who possesses cocaine entrusted to him by such Municipality :

And whereas under section 12 of the said Ordinance and Excise Notification No. 39, published in the *Government Gazette* of November 20, 1914, no person can import or transport cocaine without first obtaining a pass in that behalf to be granted by the Government Agent or by the Principal Collector of Customs, as the case may be :

It is hereby notified by the Excise Commissioner, under the powers delegated to him in that behalf by Excise Notification No. 1, published in the *Government Gazette* of December 13, 1912, and in pursuance of sections 24 and 13 of "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1912," that the fees, periods, restrictions, conditions, and forms of licenses for the sale and possession of cocaine, and of the passes aforesaid shall be as follows :—

1. (1) *Wholesale Cocaine License*.—This license will have to be taken out by those chemists and druggists and others who import cocaine largely, and sales by them under this license will be allowed only to holders of "wholesale" or "retail" cocaine licenses. The annual fee for this license will be Rs. 5.

(2) *Retail Cocaine License*.—This license will be issued on payment of an annual fee of Rs. 10. This license will not, except in special circumstances, be issued to dentists or veterinary surgeons.

(3) *Professional License to Registered and Qualified Medical Practitioners, Registered or Licensed Dentists, and Qualified Veterinary Surgeons, who do not want a Retail License, for the Possession of Cocaine for use in the exercise of their Profession*.—No sale whatever will be allowed under this license. This license will be issued free.
