Hambantota S. O. No. 1,257.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Awaseidama, situate in the village of Medilla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on October 1, 1909, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Awaseidama, situate in the village of Medilla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 1 acre 2 roods and 26 perches, and shown as lot 17 in preliminary plan 315 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Walter Ernest Wait, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 3,589):



Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
