

And whereas (1) Nemielle Helagedara Ratnayaka Mudiyanselage Ranmenika made claim to the above-mentioned lots 1, 1R, 1S, 1T, and 12, and (2) Nemielle Bogahapitiye Herat Mudiyanselage Tissahamy and (3) Diulgahawattegedara Herat Mudiyanselage Ganeti made claim to the above-mentioned lots 1Q, 1Q1, 1Q3, 1Q4, 1Q5, 1Q7, 1Q8, and 1Q9, and whereas the said 1st claimant came to an agreement dated August 7, 1913, whereby in consideration of her being declared along with Ratnayaka Mudiyanselage Ganeti and ditto Suduappu the owners of 3 acres more or less of lot 1 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 202, now shown as lot 1U on the same block survey preliminary plan, she withdrew her claim to the above-mentioned lots 1, 1R, 1S, 1T, and 12 of this order, and whereas the said 2nd claimant by an agreement dated August 7, 1913, in consideration of being declared along with Herat Mudiyanselage Heen Banda the owner of 3 acres more or less of lot 1Q of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 202, now shown as lot 1Q2 on the same block survey preliminary plan, and the said 3rd claimant by an agreement dated August 7, 1913, in consideration of being declared the owner of 3 acres more or less of lot 1Q of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 202, now shown as lot 1Q6 on the same block survey preliminary plan, withdrew their claims to the above-mentioned lots 1Q, 1Q1, 1Q3, 1Q4, 1Q5, 1Q7, 1Q8, and 1Q9 of this order, I, John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on April 19, 1916, order and declare, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.


