No. 25 of 1916.

An Ordinance to amend "The Medical Wants Ordinance, No. 9 of 1912."

JOHN ANDERSON.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Medical Wants Ordinance, No. 9 of 1912": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Medical Wants (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 25 of 1916."

Addition of a paragraph to section 30.

2 The following paragraph shall be added to section 30 of the principal Ordinance, immediately after paragraph (g) of the said section:

(h) Any expenditure incurred under any general scheme undertaken by the authority of Government for combating any disease prevalent among estate labourers which the Governor, on the recommendation of the Medical Wants Committee, may direct to be so debited.

**No. 26 of 1916.**

An Ordinance to amend "The Customs Duties  
Amendment Ordinance, 1898."

JOHN ANDERSON.

Preamble. **W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Customs Duties Amendment Ordinance, 1898": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title. **1** This Ordinance may be cited as "The Customs Duties Amendment Ordinance, No. 26 of 1916."

Substitution of new definition of "kerosine oil." **2** For the definition of "kerosine oil" in section 3 of the principal Ordinance the following definition shall be substituted:

"Kerosine oil" shall include the liquids commonly known by the names of rock oil, Rangoon oil, Burma oil, kerosine, petroleum, paraffin oil, mineral oil, petroline, gasoline, benzol, benzoline, benzine, and any liquid that is made from petroleum, coal, schist, peat, or any other bituminous substance, or from any products of petroleum with a flashing point of less than 150° F., and any inflammable hydrocarbon (including any mixture of hydrocarbon and any liquid containing hydrocarbon) which is capable of being used for providing reasonably efficient motive power for a motor car.

Substitution of new section 5. **3** For section 5 of the principal Ordinance the following new section shall be substituted:

Rebate of duty on kerosine oil used in oil engines. **5** (1) A rebate shall be allowed by the Principal Collector of Customs of duty paid on kerosine oil used as the source of motive power in stationary oil engines and in engines of vehicles employed in the transport of goods on such conditions and upon the production of such certificate and such evidence as may be prescribed by regulations to be made by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under this Ordinance.

(2) The rebate shall be paid out of the duties received by the Principal Collector of Customs, anything in section 16 of the Ordinance No. 17 of 1869 to the contrary notwithstanding.

Short title. **1** This Ordinance may be cited as "The Customs Amendment (War Powers) Ordinance, No. of 1916."
