ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1916.

WESTERN PROVINCE

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season: in Salpiti korale and Hapitigam korale the paddy plants are thriving, and in Hewagam korale the plants are earing. In Siyane korale west and Alutkuru korale south the undamaged plants are also thriving.

Maha season: nil; but in Siyane korale west, Alutkuru korale north, and Hapitigam korale preparations are being made for the maha season.

Dry grains: nil; but in Siyane korale east ground is being prepared for cultivation of kurakkan in some parts of the district, and in others the kurakkan and amu cultivations are about three months old. In Siyane korale west kurakkan plants are ripening, but not thriving.

Other products: (a) flowering prospects of coconuts are fair; (b) vegetables are rather scarce; (c) fruits, such as pineapples, oranges, jak fruits, and breadfruits, are also scarce.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5 \cdot 50 to Rs. 6 \cdot 50 per bushel ; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 35 to Rs. 45 per 1,000.

Harvest prospects: nil; but in Hapitigam korale and Colombo Mudaliyar's division the harvest prospect is fair.

Rainfall: there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants: generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, enteric, and malarial fever. Health of cattle: satisfactory, except for 1 case of rinderpest in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, 3 in Salpiti korale, 3.31 and 13 in Alutkuru korale south. İn Alutkuru korale north rinderpest is prevailing at Lokilangomuwa, Liyanagemulla, and Mellawegedera, &c.

The yala crop is being reaped.

Dry grain is cultivated in the district only on a small scale.

Coconut, tea, cinnamon, rubber, and vegetables are the general products. The estimated coconut crop for the month was 12,225,000. Vegetables produced in some parts of the district were in excess of the local demand.

Coast rice, varied from Rs. 3 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy, varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 to Rs.

varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 3 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 60 per 1,000.

The rainfall was plentiful. The heavy gale that prevailed caused considerable loss to life and property.

The harvest promises on the whole to be satisfactory.

The health of the people was good, but a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, and enteric fever occurred

MATARA DISTRICT.

Weather: generally wet. Agriculture: yala crops being reaped. Prospects very poor owing to recent floods.

Health of people: not satisfactory owing to an epidemic of malarial fever.

Health of cattle: good.

Food supply: paddy, Rs. 2.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 40 per 1,000.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation: yala crops are ripe.

Fine grain: Indian corn cultivation is maturing.

Weather: maximum temperature, 89.9°; minimum temperature, 72.4°; rainfall, 3.38 in.

Health of people ()malarial fever prevails in West Giruwa pattu.

Health of cattle: good.

Coast rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; country rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 5 60 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 50 per 1,000; plantain bunches, Rs. 60 per 100; Indian corn, Re. 1 50 per 100; pumpkins, Rs. 30 per 100; sweet potatoes, Rs. 2 per cwt.

About 220,422 coconuts were picked during the month.

Coconuts: condition of flowers and nuts moderate; price, Rs. 6 per 100.

Palmyras: fruits ripening; crop, average. Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2·25 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5·50 per bushel; pairu, Rs. 4·25 per bushel; varaku, Re. 1 75 per bushel; salt, 4 cents per pound; salt, 9 cents per measure.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

Rainfall registered at Mannar: 3:10 in.
