ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 1916.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season : in Colombo Mudaliyar's division and Salpiti korale the paddy plants are thriving well. In Alutkuru korale south the undamaged plants are thriving; and in Hewagam korale the yala season is ripe, and will be harvested in September.

Maha : nil. But in Siyane korale west, Alutkuru korale north, and Hapitigam korale fields are being sown, and in Hewagam korale some fields are being cultivated.

Dry grains : nil. But in Siyane korale west the kurakkan crop for the yala season is being reaped, and preparations are being made in some villages for the cultivation of amu and kurakkan for the maha season. In Siyane korale east kurakkan have been sown, and the cultivations are about 2½ months old, and in Hewagam korale kurakkan is not fit for harvesting yet.

Other products : (a) flowering prospects of coconuts are fair, excepting in Siyane korale west; (b) vegetables are rather scarce; (c) fruits, such as pineapples, mangoes, jak fruits, and breadfruits, are also scarce.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 6·25 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 40 to Rs. 45 per thousand.

Harvest prospect : generally fair.

Rainfall : there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants : generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, and enteric fever. In Alutkuru korale south there was a case of bubonic plague at Horape, which proved fatal.

Health of cattle : generally good, except for eight cases of rinderpest at Kirillapone and Welikada in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, of which six died. In Salpiti korale there were a few cases of rinderpest in the village called Siyambalagoda, and in Alutkuru korale north rinderpest is prevailing at Mukalangedera, Petigoda, Kelepitimulla, Danwelkatana estate, and Dicklande estate.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the reaping of the yala harvest commenced during the month.

Dry grain : there is no dry grain cultivation worth reporting.

Other products : (a) vegetables and fruit were scarce. There was a limited supply of yams and cassava bulbs in the totamunes. (b) The flowering of coconuts was satisfactory. The month's crop is estimated at 2,940,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products : Coast rice, Rs. 4·50 to Rs. 7 per bushel; country rice, in Pasdun korale east, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a fairly good harvest could have been expected if not for the damage done in some parts by the recent floods.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 6·51 in.; average, .21 in.

Health of people : there were two fatal cases of plague in the totamunes. Measles, chickenpox, dysentery, and contagious fever were prevalent in the totamunes, and there were a few cases of fever in Pasdun korale west.

Health of cattle : good.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala fields are being harvested. Maha fields are being sown.
 Dry grain cultivation : yala chenas are ripening. Maha chenas are being cleared.
