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FINAL ORDERS.

Galle S. O. No. 372.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kerandeniyehena, Berawewala, Okanda, Rathmalgodellewatta (reservation for footpath), Rathmalgodellehena, Gulanagodahena, and Diyawaladeniya, situate in the village of Embalagedera, in the Hinidum pattu of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Bogahamulahena, situate in the village of Pambegama, in the Mahagalboda Egoda korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


