and whereas the said 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th claimants by an agreement dated the 6th day of June, 1913, in consideration of being declared the purchasers of 7 acres 1 rood and 6 perches more or less of lot 8D of the notice, upon payment on or before the 30th day of September, 1913, of a sum of Rs. 72 50, and the said 4th claimant by an agreement dated on the same day in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 1 acre more or less of lot 8D of the notice upon payment on or before the 30th day of September, 1913, of a sum of Rs. 10, they withdrew their claims to the remainder of lot 8D, and whereas it was further agreed by the said two agreements entered into by the said 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, and 4th claimants that in default of the said payments of Rs. 72.50 and Rs. 10 their claims to the said two portions of lot 8D should be considered to have been withdrawn, and the said two portions of lot 8D should be declared to be the property of the Crown, and whereas the said two payments of Rs. 72 50 and Rs. 10 were not made by the due date ; and the said 10th claimant by an agreement dated the 6th day of June. 1913, in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 2 acres more or less of lot 17 of the notice and of the block survey preliminary plan 189 now included in the above-mentioned lot 17 of this order, upon payment of a sum of Rs. 20, on or before 30th Spetember, 1913, withdrew his claim to the remainder of the said lot 17, and whereas it was further agreed by the said agreement that in default of the said payment of Rs. 20 by the due date, the claim of the said 10th claimant to the said 2 acres more or less, in respect of which the said payment was to be made should be considered to have been withdrawn, and the said 2 acres more or less should also be declared the property of the Crown, and whereas the said claimant has failed to make the said payment by the due date, I, Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 29th day of June, 1916, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.




