NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following Specification has been accepted:—

"An apparatus for indicating the rate of bark consumption in the process of tapping rubber trees and the like."

Abstract:—

The apparatus, in the model described in the Provisional Specification, consists of a metal plate faced on one side with rubber numerals spaced at an equal and given distance apart; of a scale marked along one edge of the reverse of that plate; of one other edge of that plate being flanged and chamfered to a chisel edge for the purpose of acting as a scraper to remove the outside bark surface of the tree; and of a handle like the handle of an ordinary rubber stamp.

The apparatus is intended to be used for stamping the numerals in vertical succession on the surface of the tree to be tapped: a more or less smooth surface being prepared for that purpose by scraping the bark with the chamfered edge of the apparatus. The spacing of those numerals is arranged so that each indicates the amount of paring of the bark in the process of tapping that should be accomplished in the predetermined unit period of time indicated by the unit numeral. Fractions of that unit period can be read from the sub-divided scale engraved on the reverse of the stamp.

The purpose of the invention is indicated in the title. In the Provisional Specification the invention was limited to a stamp with numerals. In the complete Specification, words, letters, and marks are referred to, and "marks" are claimed.

The claims are:—

1. An apparatus for the stamping or marking of rubber trees and the like with such marks and in such a manner that the rate of bark consumption is indicated at a glance, substantially as is hereinbefore described.

2. An apparatus for the stamping of rubber trees and the like (substantially as and for the purpose hereinbefore described), and so obtaining a good renewal of bark before re-tapping the same portion of the trees.

3. An apparatus substantially as hereinbefore described and illustrated, consisting of a combined scraper and stamp substantially as and for the purpose hereinbefore described.

4. An apparatus substantially as hereinbefore described and illustrated, consisting of a combined scraper stamp and scale substantially as and for the purpose hereinbefore described.
