SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH NOVEMBER, 1916.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season: in most divisions the crop has been reaped and threshed. Maha season: fields are being sown in some places. In some korales plants are growing and thriving well.

Other products: flowering and prospects of coconuts fairly good. The estimated crop for the month is 22,194,004

Fruits and vegetables are to be had in fair quantity.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 35 to Rs. 45 per 1,000.

Harvest prospect: generally good.

Rainfall: there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants: generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, enteric fever, and measles. Health of cattle: rinderpest exists at Attidiya and Kirillapone in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, Heiyantuduwa in Siyane korale west, Siyambalagoda in Salpiti korale, Peliyagoda Gangaboda in Alutkuru korale south, Yatiyane, Boragodawatta, Udayartoppuwa, and Kandawala in Alutkuru korale north, Talahena, Hiripitiya, and Henpita, in Hewagam korale, and in division No. 53a in Hapitigam korale.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is thriving well.

Dry grain: there is no dry grain cultivation at present.

Other products: (a) fruit and vegetables were scarce, except in the totamunes, where there was a fair supply. In the totamunes there was also a fair supply of yams. (b) The flowering of coconuts was good. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 2,995,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: imported rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel; country rice, in Pasdun korale east, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: nothing can be said at present of the coming harvest. Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 10·18 in.; average, '33 in.

Health of people: in the totamunes there was one fatal case of plague and several cases of chickenpox, dysentery, fever, and measles. Several cases of measles were also reported from Pasdun korale east. Health of cattle: good.

Prospects of coconut cultivation: the estimated crop during the month is: Yatinuwara, 35,000; Tumpane, 15,000; Harispattu, 45,000; Pata Hewaheta, 461,530; Udapalata, 105,000. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions. Flowering of coconuts has been fair.

Health of people: satisfactory, but measles, chickenpox, sore-eyes, and dysentery prevailed in some villages.

Health of cattle : good.

Rainfall: satisfactory.

Paddy: paddy plants at Chempianar and Uppuveli are thriving after the recent rain. Munmari cultivation in Koddiyar pattu is fair. Munmari cultivation in Tamblegam promises a good harvest. Paddy plants in Kaddukkulam East and West have suffered badly owing to the drought.

Tobacco: planting is going on.

Coconuts: condition of crop is medium. Prices per 1,000 nuts ranges from Rs. 30 to Rs. 40.

Fishery: medium. Large quantities of fish are sold in town for drying and salting for export to outstations.

Health of people: in town there are a number of cases of fever and measles, and four cases of enteric fever have

been reported. Health of cattle: satisfactory

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.80 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 4.50 to Rs. 6.16 per bushel; rice (imported) Rs. 5.88 per bushel.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNEGALA DISTRICT.

Paddy fields: the preparation of the fields for maha cultivation is over, and in some places the plants are half

Prospects: good.

Dry grain: young plants have already appeared.

Flowering and prospects of coconut: good.

Rainfall: there has been a good deal of rain during the month, including several very heavy downpours.

Health of people: good, except for the usual cases of fever, parangi, &c.

Health of cattle: good on the whole. Rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth diseases broke out in a small area of Katugampola hatpattu, but has almost been stamped out already.

Prices of food stuffs: paddy, Re. 1 75 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 25 to Rs. 2 per bushel; mutusamba, Rs. 6 50 per bushel; country rice, Rs. 5 50 per bushel; salt, 12 cents per measure; coconut, Rs. 35 per 1,000.

PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

Paddy: maha cultivation is not satisfactory for want of sufficient rain.

Dry grain: chenas have been sown.

Other products, including coconuts: flowering and prospects of the coconut crop are satisfactory. The crop in the two districts for the month is estimated at 16,911,885 coconuts. Tobacco galas are being manured in some places.

In others the yala crop is being cured. Fruit and vegetable supply unsatisfactory.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1 60 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; green gram, Rs. 5 to Rs. 5 50 per bushel; salt, 4 cents to 8 cents per pound; coconut, 4 cents to 6 cents per nut; cassava, Rs. 2 per cwt.

Rainfall of the month: Puttalam, 7.43 in.; Chilaw, 7.09 in. Harvest prospects generally: not satisfactory on the whole.

Health of inhabitants: good. A few cases of measles were prevailing in some villages.

Health of animals: no disease.

ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather: early part of the month was dry; latter part some rain.
