## SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1916.

## WESTERN PROVINCE.

## COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala season: in most divisions the crop has been reaped and threshed. Maha season: fields are being sown in some places. In some korales plants are growing and thriving well.

Other products: flowering and prospects of coconuts fairly good. The estimated crop for the month is 22,194,004 nuts. Fruits and vegetables are to be had in fair quantity.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 35 to Rs. 45 per 1,000.

Harvest prospect: generally good.

Rainfall: there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants: generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, dysentery, enteric fever, and measles.

Health of cattle: rinderpest exists at Attidiya and Kirillapone in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, Heiyantuduwa in Siyane korale west, Siyambalagoda in Salpiti korale, Peliyagoda Gangaboda in Alutkuru korale south, Yatiyane, Boragodawatta, Udayartoppuwa, and Kandawala in Alutkuru korale north, Talahena, Hiripitiya, and Henpita, in Hewagam korale, and in division No. 53A in Hapitigam korale.

## KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is thriving well.

Dry grain: there is no dry grain cultivation at present.

Other products: (a) fruit and vegetables were scarce, except in the totamunes, where there was a fair supply. In the totamunes there was also a fair supply of yams. (b) The flowering of coconuts was good. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 2,995,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: imported rice, Rs. 4.25 to Rs. 7 per bushel; country rice, in Pasdun korale east, Rs. 6 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 nuts.

Health of cattle : satisfactory.
