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THE GOVERNOR. PROCLAMATIONS BY

In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir John Anderson, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

JOHN ANDERSON.

HEREAS the Chief Headman's division of Alutkuru korale north, Western Province, was by Proclamation dated April 24, 1888, and published in Government Gazette No. 4,857 of April 27, 1888, brought under the operation of "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1871":

And whereas by a Proclamation dated December 3, 1898, and published in Government Gazette No. 5,590 of Décember 9, 1898, the town of Minuwangoda (as defined in the schedule to this Proclamation), situate in the said division, was brought under the operation of "The Local Boards Ordinance, 1898":

And whereas it is expedient that the said town of Minuwangoda should be exempted from the operation of "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889":

Now know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in exercise of the powers vested in Us by section 4 A of "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889," as amended by section 1 of Ordinance No. 14 of 1893, and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby, as from and after the date hereof, exclude the said town of Minuwangoda (defined as aforesaid) from the operation of the said "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889."

Given at Kandy, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Fifth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Seventeen.

SCHEDULE

The bazaars of Minuwangoda as comprised within the following limits:-

North.—The tract of fields separating the villages Minuwangoda and Medamulla.

South.—Minuwangoda-oya and pita or Bogaha-ela.

East.—Land called Kelagahawatta belonging to Udias Appu and others and the Buddhist temple, and eastern boundary of the land belonging to Madalena Fonse and others.

West.—Land called Beligahawatta belonging to the heirs of the late Francis

de Croos.

W HEREAS in pursuance of the said "The Trading with the Enemy (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, No. 13 of 1916," We did by Our Proclamation, published in the Government Gazette of the 25th day of August, 1916, publish the Royal Proclamations and Orders of the Lords in Council issued under "The Trading with the Enemy (Extension of Powers) Act, 1915":

And whereas We did by Our Proclamations, published in the Government Gazette on the 8th, 15th, and 29th days of September, 20th day of October, 10th day of November, and 8th day of December, 1916, publish subsequent Orders of the Lords in Council:

And whereas further Orders of the Lords in Council have been issued dated the 7th and the 10th days of November, 1916:

Know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in pursuance of "The Trading with the Enemy (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, No. 13 of 1916," aforesaid, do hereby publish for general information the aforesaid Orders in Council dated the 7th and the 10th days of November, 1916, and appearing in the schedule hereto.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Eighth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Seventeen.

Note (3).—The list for each country is sent by telegraph to His Majesty's Representative in that country, who will notify British Consular Officers, to whom persons abroad should apply for information as to names on the list; but firms in the United Kingdom with branches abroad are advised to furnish such branches with copies of the Statutory List. The lists for all countries in Central and South America are also telegraphed to His Majesty's Ambassador at Washington.

The Foreign Trade Department is prepared on application to inquire of His Majesty's Representatives abroad for the names of substitutes for any firm on the Statutory List. When the applicant wishes this done by telegraph, he must undertake to pay the cost of the telegraphic correspondence. A considerable amount of information is, however, already available at the Foreign Trade Department, and it is hoped that it may be possible in many cases to suggest the names of satisfactory substitutes in response to inquiries, without the necessity of referring the matter abroad. It would greatly facilitate the work of this Department if applicants in making inquiries would specify the particular trade or trades for which substitutes are required.

As from and after the date hereof, subject as hereinafter provided, the importation into the United Kingdom of the following goods is hereby prohibited, viz.:—

Jewellery and all manufactures of gold and silver other than watches and watch cases.

Provided always, and it is hereby declared, that this prohibition shall not apply to any such goods which are imported under license given by or on behalf of the Board of Trade, and subject to the provisions and conditions of such license.

This Proclamation may be cited as the Prohibition of Import (No. 11) Proclamation, 1916.

"THE LOCAL BOARDS ORDINANCE, 1898."

It is hereby notified that the following amended by-laws have been made by the Local Board of Health and Improvement, Jaffna, under section 57 of "The Local Boards Ordinance, 1898," in substitution for by-laws Nos. 2, 4, 5, and 6 of the by-laws relating to dairies made by the said Board under sub-section (5) of section 56 of the said Ordinance, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 6,727 of July 16, 1915, and that the same have been confirmed by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council.

BY-LAWS REFERRED TO.

- 1. Dairymen supplying milk within Local Board limits shall register their names and addresses at the office of the Local Board.
- 2. No dairy shall be allowed within 30 feet of a cesspit or latrine, or in a position where bad odours wafted from such will reach it.
- 3. Every dairy compound shall be sufficiently provided with proper drainage to the satisfaction of the Chairman, and the drains shall be kept flushed: no foul water shall be allowed in a dairy compound.
- 4. The dairy compound shall be kept scrupulously clean. Cowdung snall be kept in the remotest corner of the compound, and removed from the compound at least twice a week.
- 5. Water for dairy use shall be procured from a pure water supply. If the water is procured from a well in the dairy compound, such well shall be adequately protected from contamination by soakage from the surrounding soil, and no bathing or washing of clothes shall be done within 15 feet of such well.
- 6. Milk and dairy utensils shall not be kept or stored in any room or portion of a building occupied by human beings.
- 7. The milk cows must be free from any disease, and all dairymen must be free from any cutaneous or infectious disease. No water or other foreign liquid or substance shall be added to the milk.
- 8. All utensils, furniture, and other requisites used in or belonging to a dairy shall be kept clean.
- 9. All vessels sent out containing milk shall be properly covered, stoppered, or corked, and shall not be carried under the armpit, nor shall the mouth of bottles be fingered.

"THE FOREST ORDINANCE, 1907."

T is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following rule, in substitution for rule 3 of the rules made under section 21 of the Forest Ordinance, No. 16 of 1907, dated May 3, 1909:-

No person shall kill or take or pursue or attempt to kill or take any deer in any up-country forest in any other manner than by hunting with a pack of hounds which has been duly registered in accordance with these rules. This rule shall not apply within 2 miles (a) of the boundaries of forest plantations and of areas under re-afforestation and (b) of the town limits of Nuwara Eliya.

"THE TOWN SCHOOLS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following by-laws made by the Municipal Council of Kandy for the five divisions which comprise the entire Municipality of Kandy, under sections 7 and 8 of the Ordinance No. 5 of 1906, and confirmed by the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, are published for general information.

By-laws made under Sections 7 and 8 of "The Town Schools Ordinance, 1906," for the Area described in the Schedule hereto by the Municipal Council of Kandy.

1. Definitions.—In these by-laws-

The terms "boy" and "child" mean a boy or a child residing in the area described in the Schedule A hereto.

The term "parent" includes a guardian and any person who has the actual custody of the child.

The term "Code" means the Code for Aided Schools for the time being sanc-

tioned by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

The term "attendance" means an attendance for the period defined by the Code as constituting a full attendance recorded in an Attendance Register in the manner prescribed by the Code.

The term "school" means a school specified in the Schedule B hereto.

The term "Inspector of Schools" means an Inspector of Schools appointed by ·His Excellency the Governor.

- Children to attend School.—The parent of every boy of not less than 6 nor more than 12 years of age shall cause such boy to attend one of the schools specified in Schedule B, unless he has made other adequate and suitable provision for the education of such boy, or unless there is a reasonable excuse for non-attendance.
- Time of Attendance.—The time during which every boy shall attend school shall be the whole time for which the school shall be open for the instruction of children of similar age.
 - Religion.—Provided always that nothing in these by-laws-
 - (a) Shall prevent the presence of children being excused during the hours when religious instruction is given, as provided by section 9 (2) (d) of "The Town Schools Ordinance, 1906."
 - (b) Shall require any child to attend school on any day specially set apart for religious observance by the religious body to which its parent belongs.
- And provided always that when a child between 10 and 12 years of age, being beneficially employed to the satisfaction of the Chairman of the Municipal Council, has received a certificate from an Inspector of Schools that it has passed in Reading, Writing, and Arithmetic, the Fourth Standard prescribed by the Code for the time being, it shall not be required to attend school.
- Every parent who shall not observe, or shall neglect or violate, these by-laws or any of them, shall upon conviction be liable to a penalty not exceeding Rs. 20 for each offence, and an additional fine not exceeding Rs. 10 per day in the case of a continuing offence.

Note.—The following are the portions of the Town Schools Ordinance referred to in sections 2 and 4 of these by-laws:

Section 8 (1) (b).—A parent shall be deemed to have made adequate and suitable provision for the education of his child if he proves that his child is in regular attendance at a school registered by the Director of Public Instruction for the receipt of a grant in aid, or at a school with regard to which an application for a grant in aid is under consideration, or at a school certified by the Director of Public Instruction to provide adequate and suitable instruction; or if he proves that he has made such other provision for his child's education as the Director of Public Instruction shall certify to be adequate and suitable, or if he produces a certificate from the Director of Public Instruction recommending that the child shall be exempted from compulsory attendance. Provided that no parent shall be convicted for not causing his child to attend such school if he proves to the satisfaction of the Magistrate that he has reasonable excuse for not causing such child to attend. A parent shall be deemed to have a reasonable excuse for not causing his child to attend school if he proves that the child is prevented from attending by sickness or other unavoidable cause.

Section 9 (2).—No school in which religious instruction is given shall be named in any by-law made under clause (a) of the last preceding section as a school in which efficient provision is made for vernacular education, unless the local authority is

(a) That religious instruction is given only during the times specified in the school time table.

(b) That religious instruction is not given to pupils of other denominations than that to which the school belongs if the parents object

(c) That pupils who do not attend religious instruction are employed in other studies during the hours allotted to religious instruction;

(d) That such pupils, if their parents object to their being present in the room where religious instruction is given, are either allowed to study in some other part of the school premises during the hours when such instruction is given, or their presence in the school during such hours is excused; and

(e) That a copy of sub-section (2) of this section in the English, Sinhalese, and Tamil languages is conspicuously posted up in the school.

The above by-laws were made by the Municipal Council of Kandy at a meeting held on September 4, 1909, and revised and amended at a meeting held on November 20, 1915, and further amended at a meeting held on August 19, 1916.

Limits.—In length the portion of the high road lying between the 23 milestone on the Kandy-Galagedara road and the 3rd milepost on the Kandy-Panwila road and between the Ping-oya bridge and the 3rd milestone on the Matale road, and in breadth one hundred yards on the north, south, and west of the said roads, and on the east up to the Mahaweli-ganga, and on the south-west of the Matale road up to the Ping-oya.

VITAL STATISTICS.

Registrar-General's Weekly Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended December 30, 1916.

Births.—The total births registered in the city of Colombo in the week were 102 (2 Europeans, 11 Burghers, 56 Sinhalese, 13 Tamils, 18 Moors, and 2 Maleys). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on July 1, 1916, viz., 259,451) was 20.6, as against 23.8 in the preceding week, 22.6 in the corresponding week of last year, and 22.7 the weekly average for last year.

Deaths.—The total deaths registered were 152 (1 European, 6 Burghers, 68 Sinhalese, 43 Tamils, 27 Moors, 5 Malays, and 2 Others). The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 30·6, as against 25·2 in the previous week, 22·8 in the corresponding week of last year, and 25·8 the weekly average for last year.

Infantile Deaths.—Of the 152 total deaths, 33 were of infants under one year of age, as against 36 in the preceding week, 23 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 29 the average for last year.

Stillbirths.—The number of stillbirths registered during the week was 9.

Principal Causes of Death.—Twenty-one deaths from Phthisis were registered, as against 19 in the previous week and 15 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 7 were in Maradana (including 2 deaths of non-residents in hospitals), 4 in Kotahena, 3 in St. Paul's, 2 in New Bazaar, 2 in Kollupitiya, 1 in San Sebastian, 1 in Slave Island, and 1 in Wellawatta.

- 2. Eighteen deaths from *Pneumonia* were registered, as against 15 in the previous week and 11 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 5 were in Kotahena, 5 in Maradana, 5 in Wellawatta, 2 in St. Paul's, and 1 in Slave Island. Three deaths from *Bronchitis* were registered.
- 3. Seven deaths from *Plague* were registered, as against 1 in the previous week and 2 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 4 were in St. Paul's, 1 in Pettah, 1 in Kotahena, and 1 in Slave Island. Nine cases were reported, as against 5 in the previous week.
- 4. Three deaths from *Enteric Fever* were registered, as against 2 in the previous week and 3 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 1 was in Kotahena, 1 in New Bazaar, and 1 in Maradana.
- 5 One death from *Measles* was registered (in Kotahena), as against 2 in the previous week. There were reported 24 cases of *Measles*, as against 32 in the previous week; and 20 cases of *Chickenpox*, as against 18 in the previous week.
- 6. Ten deaths from Infantile Convulsions were registered, 8 from Debility, 6 from Enteritis, 4 from Dysentery, 2 from Worms, 1 from Tetanus, and 68 from Other Causes.

State of the Weather.—The mean temperature of air was 76.8°, against 78.1° in the preceding week and 79.0° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29.910 in., against 29.890 in. in the preceding week and 29.866 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was nil, same as in the preceding week, against 0.59 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
