### SCHEDULE.

#### Section III.

#### Ship's Tackle.

10. Commanders of vessels or, in their absence, the officers in charge and contractors or their agents or servants engaged in shipping or discharging cargo or coal or other articles shall not use or suffer or permit to be used any ropes, tackle, or other gear that may be worn, frail, or otherwise unsuitable from any cause whatever for the purpose of heaving or lowering such cargo or coal or other articles, nor shall they permit any one of unsound mind or any one under the age of 16 years to drive or in any way control any steam winch or other machine used for heaving or lowering such cargo or coal or other articles. Any police officer not below the rank of sergeant may at any time inspect and examine such ropes, tackle, or other gear, and prohibit their use if found unsuitable.

And whereas by Our Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* of the 23rd day of October, 1915, the Royal Proclamation aforesaid was brought into operation in the Colony of Ceylon, and the articles of contraband were published in Schedules A and B thereof:

And whereas by Royal Proclamations issued His Majesty made certain amendments in and additions to the schedules aforesaid, and the said Proclamations were brought into operation in the said Colony by Our Proclamations published in the *Government Gazette* on the 17th day of March, 16th day of June, 11th day of August, and 10th day of November, 1916, respectively:

And whereas by Royal Proclamation issued the 23rd day of November, 1916, His Majesty made further amendments in and additions to the schedules aforesaid:

Now know Ye that We, the Governor, do hereby proclaim that the Royal Proclamation of the 23rd day of November, 1916, published in the schedule hereto, is in force in the said Colony, and do call upon all His Majesty's subjects and all other persons being in the said Colony to govern themselves accordingly.

**SCHEDULE.**

**BY THE KING.**

A PROCLAMATION making certain Additions to and Amendments in the List of Articles to be treated as Contraband of War.

GEORGE R.I.

WHEREAS on the 14th day of October, 1915, We did issue Our Royal Proclamation specifying the articles which it was Our intention to treat as contraband during the continuance of hostilities, or until We did give further public notice; and

Whereas on the 27th day of January, 1916, the 12th day of April, 1916, the 27th day of June, 1916, and the 3rd day of October, 1916, We did, by Our Royal Proclamations of those dates, make certain additions to and modifications in the said list of articles to be treated as contraband; and

Whereas it is expedient to make certain further additions to the said list:

Now, therefore, We do hereby declare, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, that during the continuance of the war, or until We do give further public notice, the following articles will be treated as absolute contraband, in addition to those set out in Our Royal Proclamations aforementioned:—

- Diamonds suitable for industrial purposes.
- Silk in all forms and the manufactures thereof; silk cocoons.
- Artificial silk and the manufactures thereof.
- Quillaia bark.
- Zirconium, cerium, thorium, and all alloys and compounds thereof.
- Zirconia and monazite sand.

And We do hereby further declare that, as from this date, the following amendments shall be made in schedule 1 of Our Royal Proclamation of the 14th day of October, 1915, aforementioned :—

For item 4, “ emery, corundum, natural and artificial (alundum), and carborundum in all forms,” there shall be substituted “ emery, corundum, carborundum, and all other abrasive materials whether natural or artificial, and the manufactures thereof.”

And We do hereby further declare that, as from this date, the following amendments shall be made in Our Royal Proclamation of the 12th day of April, 1916, aforementioned :—

For “ gold, silver, paper money, and all negotiable instruments and realizable securities,” there shall be substituted “ gold, silver, paper money, securities, negotiable instruments, cheques, drafts, orders, warrants, coupons, letters of credit delegation or advice, credit and debit notes, or other documents, which in themselves, or if completed, or if acted upon by the recipient, authorize, confirm, or give effect to the transfer of money, credit, or securities.”

And We do hereby further declare that the following articles shall, as from this date, be treated as conditional contraband, in addition to those set out in Our Royal Proclamations aforementioned :—

Sponges, raw and prepared.

Glue, gelatine, and substances used in the manufacture thereof.

Empty barrels and casks of all kinds and their component parts.

## GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

### “THE RIOT DAMAGES ORDINANCE, No. 23 OF 1915.”

WHEREAS the Hon. Mr. J. G. Fraser, C.M.G., a Special Commissioner appointed under Ordinance No. 23 of 1915, did accept from the inhabitants and owners of property in the administrative division of (228) Boraliyawatta, Hiriwalamulla, Bulatgangoda, Tittalapitigoda, and Medawatugoda, in the Siyane korale west of the Colombo District, a mortgage bond for the amount of compensation apportioned to the said administrative division, pending full payment of the said amount by instalments :

And whereas the first, second, third, and fourth instalments of the said sum so secured have not been paid, and whereas the Commissioner proposes to proceed to allot the compensation payable by the inhabitants and owners of property in the said division as though such bond had not been accepted :

And whereas that portion of the Colombo District in which the said administrative division of Boraliyawatta, Hiriwalamulla, Bulatgangoda, Tittalapitigoda, and Medawatugoda is situated has, by Notification dated January 18, 1916, published in the *Government Gazette* No. 6,772 of January 21, 1916, been declared a riot area under “The Riot Damages Ordinance, No. 23 of 1915” :

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## Training Class for the Surveyor-General's License.

**A**N Examination for admission to the training class for the Surveyor-General's license in surveying and levelling will be held at the Colombo Observatory on Monday, March 12, 1917, and the following days, commencing at 10.30 A.M.

2. Application to enter for the examination must be made on the prescribed form, which can be obtained from the Surveyor-General.

3. The subjects of the examination are:—

Handwriting, orthography, composition, arithmetic, Geometry (first book of Euclid), Algebra (up to and including quadratic equations), Plane trigonometry (elementary), mensuration, and plan drawing.

4. Candidates who hold certificates of having passed the Senior Cambridge or other examination of similar standing, or have matriculated at the London University or any similar institution approved by His Excellency the Governor, will be exempted from this examination in all subjects, if their certificates show that they have passed in mathematics.

5. The fee will be Rs. 150 paid in advance for a course of 18 months, and a deposit of Rs. 100, which will be refunded at the end of the course, less the cost of the stores issued to the student.

6. No application will be received after March 5, 1917.

## VITAL STATISTICS.

### Registrar-General's Weekly Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended January 13, 1917.

**Births.**—The total births registered in the city of Colombo in the week were 167 (9 Burghers, 100 Sinhalese, 23 Tamils, 31 Moors, 2 Malays, and 2 Others). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on January 1, 1917, viz., 263,629) was 33·0, as against 23·3 in the preceding week, 22·1 in the corresponding week of last year, and 21·6 the weekly average for last year.

**Deaths.**—The total deaths registered were 138 (7 Burghers, 73 Sinhalese, 28 Tamils, 18 Moors, 6 Malays, and 6 Others). The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 27·3, as against 30·1 in the previous week, 24·6 in the corresponding week of last year, and 27·1 the weekly average for last year.

**Infantile Deaths.**—Of the 138 total deaths, 22 were of infants under one year of age, as against 34 in the preceding week, 19 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 25 the average for last year.

**Stillbirths.**—The number of stillbirths registered during the week was 14.

**Principal Causes of Death.**—Twenty-two deaths from *Pneumonia* were registered, as against 19 in the previous week and 15 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 8 were in Maradana (including 4 deaths of non-residents in hospitals), 6 in Kotahena, 3 in St. Paul's, 2 in Slave Island, 1 in Fort and Galle Face, 1 in Pettah, and 1 in Kollupitiya. Six deaths from *Bronchitis* were registered.

2. Eighteen deaths from *Phthisis* were registered, as against 17 in the previous week and 16 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 9 were in Maradana (including 5 deaths of non-residents in hospitals), 3 in St. Paul's, 2 in Kotahena, 2 in Wellawatta, 1 in San Sebastian, and 1 in Kollupitiya.

3. Four deaths from *Plague* were registered, as against 2 in the previous week and 4 the weekly average for last year. Of these, 1 was in Pettah, 1 in Kotahena, 1 in Slave Island, and 1 in Wellawatta. Seven cases were reported, as against 2 in the previous week.

4. Two deaths from *Enteric Fever* were registered in Maradana (1 of a non-resident in hospital), same as in the previous week, against 3 the weekly average for last year.

5. No deaths from *Measles* were registered; 4 deaths were registered in the previous week. There were reported 32 cases of *Measles*, as against 27 in the previous week; and 34 cases of *Chickenpox*, as against 28 in the previous week.

6. Ten deaths from *Debility* were registered, 9 from *Infantile Convulsions*, 6 from *Enteritis*, 2 from *Diarrhoea*, 2 from *Worms*, and 57 from *Other Causes*.

**State of the Weather.**—The mean temperature of air was 79·4°, against 78·3° in the preceding week and 78·9° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29·950 in., against 29·957 in. in the preceding week and 29·914 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 0·74 in., against nil in the preceding week and 0·31 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
