#### Kurunegala S. O. No. 1,592.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Elagawahena, Kongahamula-aswedduma, Walasgalehena, situate in the village of Medagama, in the Mahagalboda Egoda korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 20th day of February, 1914, that if no claim to the lands, commonly called or known as Elagawahena, Kongahamula-aswedduma, Walasgalehena, situate in the village of Medagama, in the Mahagalboda Egoda korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent I acre 3 roods and 38 perches, and shown as lots M 1049AD, M 1049AF, I 1047L in preliminary plan 2,033 and in the annexed diagrams, was made to John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt withon account of the Crown




