PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir JOHN ANDERSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

JOHN ANDERSON.

KNOW Ye that We, the said Governor, in pursuance of "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914," do hereby prohibit the exportation from Ceylon of the following article, that is to say:—

Specie.

Provided that the said prohibition shall be subject to the limitations and conditions following, that is to say:—

- (1) The said prohibition shall not apply to specie exported by any person leaving the Colony to an amount which does not exceed Rs. 100, and which, on demand made by any officer of Customs or Police, he shall have truly declared in writing.
- (2) The said prohibition shall not apply to specie exported in pursuance of a special license under the hand of the Colonial Secretary, or an Assistant Colonial Secretary, and in accordance with the terms of the said license.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Nineteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Seventeen.
