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DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1917."

Further proviso to paragraph (f) of section 22 of principal Ordinance.

2 The following further proviso shall be added in continuation, and at the end, of paragraph (f) of section 22 of the principal Ordinance, as amended by "The Ceylon Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 26 of 1914":

Provided further that the provisions of this section shall not apply when cocaine is sent—

- (i.) To a person licensed to possess or deal in cocaine; or
- (ii.) On the prescription of a registered and qualified medical practitioner or a qualified veterinary surgeon.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object is to amend "The Post Office Ordinance, 1908," by adding a further proviso at the end of section 22 (f), so as to permit the transmission by post of cocaine—

- (a) To persons licensed to possess or deal in cocaine; and
(b) Upon the prescription of a qualified medical practitioner.

2. The prohibition against sending cocaine by post, as it now exists, was intended only to regulate the introduction of cocaine into the Island, and not to interfere with its legitimate use within the Island.
