ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1917.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha season is now over.

Yala season: in some divisions plants are thriving well, and in some places fields are being prepared for yala sowing. Other products: flowering and prospects of coconuts are fairly good. The estimated crop for the month is 27,153,570 Fruits and vegetables are to be had in fair quantity.

Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 6·75 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 30 to Rs. 40 per 1,000.

Harvest prospects: generally good. Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants: generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, enteric fever, and measles.

Health of cattle: generally good, except for three cases of rinderpest and six cases of hoof-and-mouth disease, in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, two cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Salpiti korale, hoof-and-mouth disease broken out in the villages of Napagoda, Nambadaluwa, Kamburagalla, Ratambale, and Kongahadeniya, in Siyane korale east, twentyseven cases in Alutkuru korale south, few cases in Alutkuru korale north, few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease and two cases of rinderpest in Hewagam korale, and hoof-and-mouth disease prevailing in some villages in Siyane korale west.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the sowing of fields for the yala cultivation was brought to a close during the month.

Dry grain: there is no dry grain cultivation worth reporting.

Other products; there was a fair supply of vegetables and fruit, except in Pasdun korale. Jak was plentiful. The month's crop of coconuts is estimated at 3,105,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 4.37 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 35 to Rs. 60 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: there is no harvest in the near future. The paddy plants are thriving The cultivation of low lying fields had to be given up owing to their being under water.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 6.52 in.; average, 21 in.

Health of people: good, except for a few cases of chickenpox and measles.

Health of cattle: a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease occurred in the totamunes and Rayigam korale.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation-yala: fields are being ploughed. Maha: nil.

Dry grain cultivation—maha: kurakkan chenas are being reaped. Yala: sowing. Prospect of coconut cultivation: flowering has been fair. The estimated produce for the month is:—Yatinuwara, 33,000; Tumpane, 12,000; Harispattu, 40,000; Pata Hewaheta, 491,400. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Rainfall: there has been sufficient rain, except in Udunuwara, Tumpane, and Pata Dumbara.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Re. 1 · 50 to Rs. 2 · 50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 · 75 to Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 7 per 100.

Health of people: satisfactory, but there were few cases of measles, chickenpox, and dysentery.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall: Nuwara Eliya town, 1.65 in.

Paddy—maha season fields in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane: some are ripening, others are being harvested. Kotmale fields are being ploughed.

Dry grains: kurakkan chenas in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane are being harvested.

Health of population: fair. There are a few cases of chickenpox in some of the villages of Walapane and Kotmale. Health of cattle: rinderpest exists in Nuwara Eliya town. Six animals were attacked with the disease during the month, out of which five died and one recovered.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel; Indian corn, Rs. 2 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 5.75 to Rs. 8 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 6 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 6.50 to Rs. 9 per 100 nuts. MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 2.68 in.

Paddy: maha harvest is being gathered.

Dry grain: nil.

Coconuts: (a) flowering fair; (b) 115,725 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks in Matale North: some are half full, and others are one-third full. Health of people: good. There were many cases of chickenpox and measles.

Health of cattle: good.

Prices of most of the commodities have increased slightly above pre-war prices.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

The prospects of the yala crop are fair.

Dry grain is not cultivated in the district to any appreciable extent.

Coconut, tea, rubber, and vegetables are the general products. The estimated coconut crop was 12,325,770. Coast rice, varied from Rs. 3 to Rs. 7 per bushel; paddy, varied from Re. 1 62 to Rs. 3 per bushel; fine grain, varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 3 per bushel; coconut, Rs. 25 to Rs. 60 per 1,000.

The weather was generally dry.

The health of the people was on the whole satisfactory.

MATARA DISTRICT.

Weather: dry.

Agriculture: sowing for yala over. Prospects good.

Health of people: satisfactory.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Rs. 2.25 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 per bushel; pairu, Rs. 4.50 per bushel; varaku, Re. 1.50 per bushel; salt, 9 cents per measure, 4 cents per lb.

Health of people: a few cases of smallpox were reported from Kokkuvil, in the division of Jaffna, of which none proved fatal.

Health of cattle: satisfactory.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 2:33 in.

Wind: the mean direction of wind was south south-west. The weather was changeable and unsettled. Paddy: kalapokam paddy has been reaped and stacked. Ploughing is going on for sirupokam. Owing to unseasonable rain during the reaping season for kalapokam good seed paddy for sirupokam is scarce.

Tobacco: cured and ready for the market. Crop fairly satisfactory.

Health of animals: hoof-and-mouth disease has broken out in some villages.
