SEASON ABSTRACTS OF REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1917.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha season : nil.

Yala season: the paddy plants are thriving well. Other products : flowering and prospects of coconuts are fairly good. The estimated crop for the month is 28,628,711 Fruits and vegetables are to be had in fair quantity. nuts.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 6.50 per bushel; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 25 to Rs. 30 per 1,000.

Harvest prospect : generally good.

Rainfall: there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants : generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, measles, and enteric fever.

Health of cattle : generally good, except for several cases of hoof-and-mouth disease and a few cases of rinderpest in some villages in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, a few cases in Siyane korale east, 14 cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Alutkuru korale south, 5 cases of rinderpest in Hewagam korale, and a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Alutkuru korale north.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the plants of the yala cultivation are thriving well. In Panadure badda the fields had dried up for want of rain.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products: (a) fruit was scarce, except in the totamunes, where there was a fair supply. There was a fair supply of vegetables and jak, except in Pasdun korale. (b) The flowering of coconuts was good. The month's crop is estimated at 3,120,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4 25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 25 to Rs. 60 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a fairly good harvest may be expected except in the totamunes. Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 6 91 in. ; average, 22 in. Health of people : there were 3 positive cases of plague and 1 suspected case in the district, all of which ended fatally. Health of cattle : there were a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease and 2 cases of anthrax reported during the month.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala fields are in plants. Maha : nil.

Dry grain cultivation : harvesting of maha chenas in Uda Dumbara is over, chenas being sown in Udunuwara. and being cleared in Tumpane.

Prospects of coconut cultivation : flowering of coconuts has been fair. The estimated crop during the month is : Yatinuwara, 35,000 ; Tumpane, 12,000 ; Harispattu, 40,000 ; Pata Hewaheta, 500,000 ; Udapalata, 106,600. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Rainfall : rain was sufficient in all the divisions, except Udapalata.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : satisfactory, except for 3 cases of rinderpest at Gampola.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1.75 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 3 to Rs. 5 per 100 nuts.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall : Nuwara Eliya town, 1.99 in. Paddy : maha season fields in Uda Hewaheta and Walapane are being harvested. No work in Kotmale fields.

Kurakkan : no work in the chenas.

Health of population : good. There were a few cases of chickenpox and measles in some of the villages of Walapane and in Nuwara Eliya town.

Health of cattle : good. There were 15 cases of rinderpest in Nuwara Eliya town ; 10 died and 5 recovered.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 to Rs. 3 per bushel ; Indian corn, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2 '75 per bushel; rice (Coast), Rs. 5 '50 to Rs. 8 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 6 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 5 '50 to Rs. 9 per 100 nuts.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall: 3.24 in.

Paddy : yala fields in plant.

Dry grain : nil.

Coconuts : (a) flowering fair ; (b) 116,800 nuts. Tanks : in Matale North the tanks do not contain sufficient water to irrigate the fields under them owing to delay in commencing cultivation.
