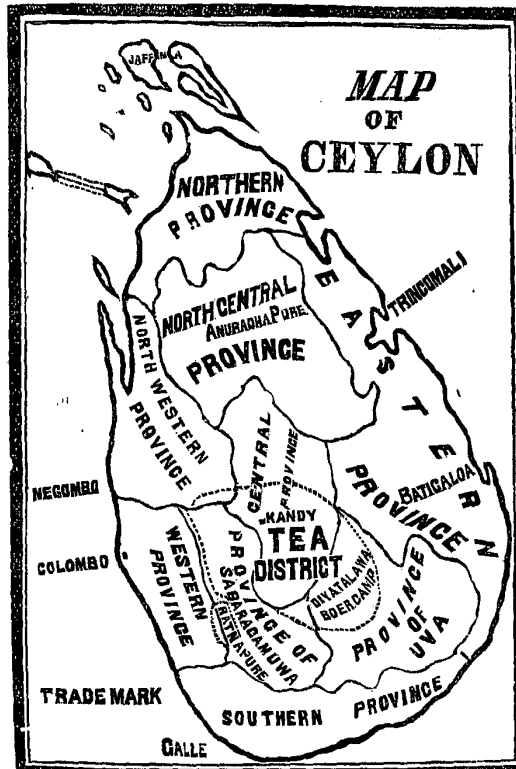

*Bay of Bengal—Burma Coast—Rangoon River—Position of Hastings Shoal Wreck Buoy altered.*

The Bombay Government has given notice (No. 71 of 1903) that information has been received from the

Principal Port Officer, Burma, Rangoon, dated July 4, 1903, that the small wreck buoy on the Hastings shoal, which had drifted out of position, has been replaced by an old-fashioned conical channel buoy painted green.

The position of the buoy is close to the south edge of the wreck.
