And whereas Pahalahiddegedara Appuhamy made claim thereto, and Ralph Marcus Meaburn Worsley, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, and whereas the said claimant and the said Ralph Marcus Meaburn Worsley, Special Officer, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing dated the 12th day of January, 1914, concerning the said lands, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimant should be declared along with Pahala Hiddagedara Kapuruhamy and ditto Ranmenika the purchasers of the said lands upon payment, on or before the 12th day of April, 1914.


