MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, May 1, 1903.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated April 25, 1903.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Mr. P. D. Khan; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Major A. W. de Wilton; Dr. C. W. van Geysel; Dr. A. Perry; Mr. F. C. Allen; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayawardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen; the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois; and Dr. W. H. de Silva.

The Minutes of April 3, 1903, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of April 3, 1903, be confirmed, the words "as before" to be deleted in the last line of the Minute on item 14 (copy of Minutes as amended is attached).

1. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—Whether the proprietor of any carriage licensed under Ordinance No. 9 of 1901 has been exempted by the Chairman from compliance with the provisions of section 2 of the said Ordinance, which requires the licensed number of the carriage to be painted and a numbered plate to be affixed thereto. If such exemption had been granted, he moved for a return of the names of persons so exempted.

The Chairman replied in the negative.

2. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—Whether any similar exemptions have been granted in respect of sections 3, 10, and 14 of chapter XXV. of the by-laws under Ordinance No. 16 of 1881.

The Chairman replied in the negative.

3. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—Whether the current used from the generator in Gasworks street to light the electric arc lamps in the Fort is carried by an overhead wire from the station in Gasworks street to the arc lighting switchboard of Galle Buck station, and if so, whether it is done with the permission of the Chairman, and moved for papers.

The Chairman replied that he is informed that the power transmitted from the generator at Gasworks street to Galle Buck station is carried by an overhead conductor as far as the National Bank corner, and thence by an underground main to Galle Buck, and that he is unable to trace any permission having been granted for this by the Chairman.

4. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—Why the diaries of the Superintendent of Works, the Sanitary Officer, and the Assistant Sanitary Officer are not laid on the table as hitherto, and moved for papers.

The Chairman replied that the Standing Committee on the Works Department had decided that the Superintendent of Works need not in future furnish a diary, and had omitted the diary from the list of documents to be furnished by the Superintendent of Works in the departmental rules drawn up by the Committee, and had further recommended in their report that all previous rules be cancelled. This report and the departmental rules were adopted by Council on February 13, 1903.

The diaries of the Sanitary Officer were not laid on the table at the Meetings of Council in March and April, 1903, owing to an oversight, and they are now ready to be laid on the table.

The Assistant Sanitary Officer's diary does not appear to be required by any resolution of Council to be laid on the table.

5. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—What progress, if any, has been made with the two experimental septic tanks for which a vote was taken last year.

The Chairman replied that the work is nearly finished and will be completed shortly, and that there was some unavoidable delay owing to the department being short-handed as regards its supervising staff.

6. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—What progress has been made with the work of improving the lighting of the Dean's road market and Campbell's park, for which provision was made last year, and moved for papers.

The Chairman replied that he is informed that the high power lamp will be fixed next week, and that the rest of the work in Dean's road market is completed, and that as regards the lighting of Campbell's park, the Gas Inspector was asked on April 16 last to proceed with the work.

7. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera asked—Whether the removal of the gas lamps opposite the Baptist Chapel and George Wall Fountain and the erection thereof near the Maradana Railway Terminus in terms of the resolution of the Standing Committee of July 18, 1902, which the Chairman stated at the Meeting of the Council of April 3 last, had been delayed by an oversight and would receive early attention, has been effected.

The Chairman replied that a site had been arranged for the lamp, and the Gas Inspector directed to proceed with the removal at once.

8. Pursuant to notice, the Hon. Mr. Stanley Bois moved—That in regard to the Committee appointed to consider the Chairman's Administration Report for 1902, three Members shall form a quorum.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

The Committee recommend that votes 61, 62, and 63 for gravelled roads, lanes, and footways be consolidated into one vote, and that votes 64 and 70 for trunk roads be also consolidated into one vote. On this being done the Committee will pass the revised estimates and request the Superintendent of Works to furnish a complete list of the roads in each division. At the close of the year a statement of expenditure on each road should be furnished.
- (7) Papers with reference to encroachment at Hedges court.
The Committee recommend that the half-improved value be paid and the encroachment removed.

Mr. P. D. Khan seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. Perera dissenting as regards items 9, 14, 15, 16, and 22 of the extracts from the Minutes of this Standing Committee.

The Chairman moved—That the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Markets and Sanitation of April 17, 1903, be passed.

Mr. P. D. Khan seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman moved—That item No. 3 contained in the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment of April 28, 1903, be considered with the proposed clerical scheme.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

Item No. 3 in Minutes of the Standing Committee on Municipal Works of April 16, 1903, was then considered.

The Chairman moved—That Mr. Dassenaik's letters of February 19 and March 31, 1903, together with the Superintendent of Works' letters No. 170 of February 28 and No. 3 of April 2, 1903, be referred to Mr. Cooper along with the other applications for report.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried.

The Chairman moved the adoption of the remaining recommendations in the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Municipal Works of the April 16, 1903, and of Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment of April 28,

1903, subject to the resolution already passed in Committee as regards item 29 of the Minutes of the Standing Committee on Finance and Assessment of April 21, 1903.

Mr. P. D. Khan seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. Perera dissenting as to items 4, 5, and 6 of the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Municipal Works.

The Chairman moved—That Council do resume, and that the recommendations in Committee be adopted.

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.—Carried. Mr. C. Perera dissenting as in Committee.

10. Report of the Special Committee appointed to consider the desirability of amending the Municipal Ordinance in regard to the qualification of voters and councillors and their method of election, and to report to the Council generally with a view to reform in this connection, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Hon. Mr. S. Bois moved the adoption of the report.

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved as an amendment that the consideration of the matter be postponed to the next Meeting of Council.
